## **HIGHLIGHTS**

- Of the new cases 193 (42.5%) are nationals.
- New infections by health area: Al Farwaniyah (135), Al Jahra (107), Al Ahmadi (88), Hawally (66) and Capital Area (40).
- Hawally shows positive indicators supportive of lifting isolation followed by Farwaniya and Khaitan.
- 66 stores shut for violating precautionary measures.
- WHO updates guidance on the use of face masks, stressing that mask use is only one component of a comprehensive approach to prevent and control COVID-19 (see link below).
- WHO clarifies comments made earlier regarding COVID-19 transmission: transmission is known to occur by symptomatic cases and pre-symptomatic cases (who later develop symptoms). More data is still needed about transmission via asymptomatic cases (who never develop symptoms). See link below.
