HIGHLIGHTS

- Of the new cases, 490 (57.9%) are nationals.
- New infections by health area: Al Jahra (291), Al Ahmadi (200), Al Farwaniyah (140), Hawally (122) and Capital Area (93).
- Parliament extends suspension for 10 more days after tea boy tests positive.
- 4,265 more expatriates left Kuwait bringing the total to 105,000 who left onboard 663 flights.
- The shift to the second stage will start from Sunday, and entails a partial curfew from 9 pm to 5 am allowing government
- institutions and ministries to resume work with 30% employees.
 Kuwait Municipality stops all its paperwork to limit the spread of coronavirus and sterilized all mortuaries facilities in cooperation with the Ministry of Defense.

- WHO releases "WHO Academy" mobile application providing COVID-19 resources for health workers in 6 UN languages.
