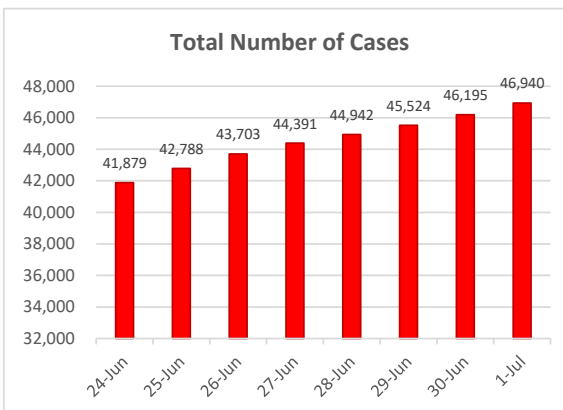
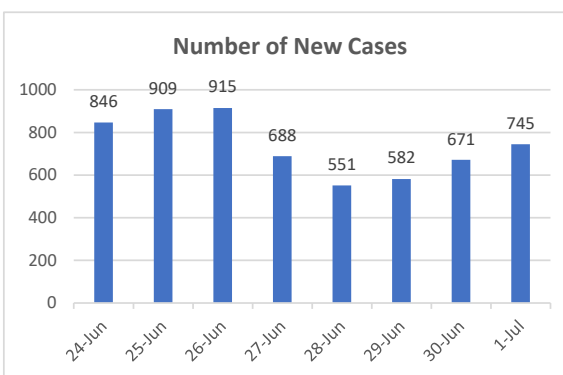

HIGHLIGHTS

- Of the new cases, 434 (58.3%) are nationals.
- New infections by health area: Al Farwaniyah (182), Al Jahra (176), Al Ahmadi (169), Capital Area (120), and Hawally (98).
- The Red Crescent distributes masks and sterilizers in a number of government institutions.
- 27 flights left Kuwait to 8 countries with 4,815 expatriates as part of the amnesty programme.
- Field surveys to collect samples continue in different locations particularly mahboula.
- Life returned yesterday to government departments after a standstill of about 4 months.
- WHO updates criteria for releasing patients from isolation (see link below).
- WHO releases "WHO Academy" mobile application providing COVID-19 resources for health workers in 6 UN languages (see link below).
