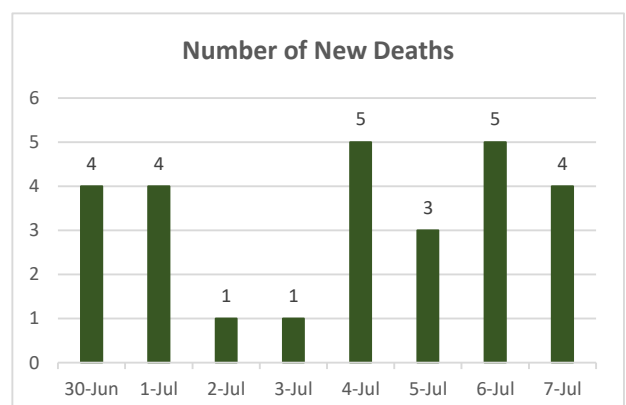
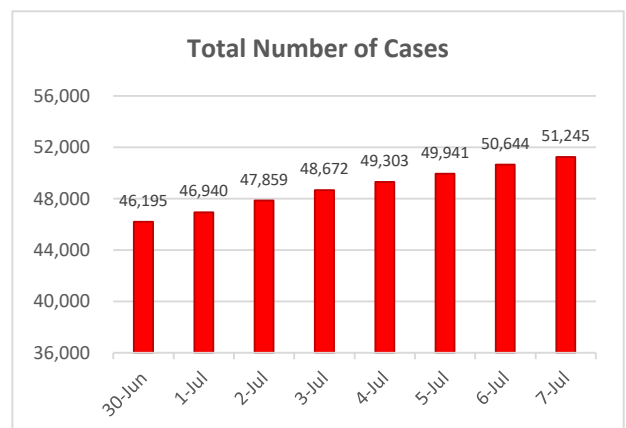
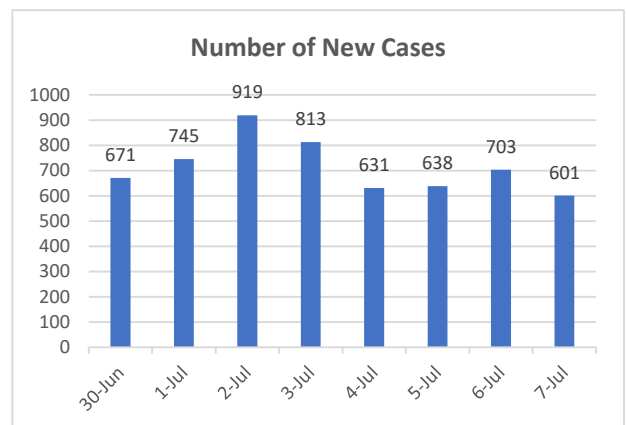

## HIGHLIGHTS

- Of the new cases, 402 (66.9%) are nationals.
- New infections by health area :Al Ahmadi (197), Al Jahra (134), Al Farwaniyah (125), Hawally (86) and Capital Area (59).
- Ministry of Awqaf and Islamic Affairs takes the necessary measures to allow Friday prayers to be held in mosques from Friday July 17.
- "Coronavirus Forum and its Impact on the Gulf Cooperation Council Countries" was launched with the participation of a group of academics and specialists.
- Kuwait Municipality closed 112 stores violating COVID-19 safety measures in June.
- Solidarity trial interim results show that hydroxychloroquine and lopinavir/ritonavir produce little or no reduction in mortality of hospitalized COVID-19 patients (see link below).
- WHO releases "WHO Academy" mobile application providing COVID-19 resources for health workers in 6 UN languages.
- WHO clarifies comments made earlier regarding COVID-19 transmission, See link below.
