HIGHLIGHTS

• Of the new cases, 1,333 (65%) are nationals.

• New infections by health area in 3 days :Al Ahmadi (706), Al Jahra (458), Al Farwaniyah (388), Hawally (289) and Capital Area (210).

• 4 health check-up centres will start providing services for expatriate labour on Sunday, appointments can be made on MoH website.

• 18 flights to 8 countries departed on Saturday carrying 3,530 expatriates, bringing total number of expatriates leaving Kuwait to around 160,000 in the past 4 months.

• MoH advises citizens against travelling abroad due to the pandemic.

• Farwaniya lockdown expected to be lifted on July 21.

• The Red Crescent distributes masks and sterilisers in the National Evangelical Church which was opened while the Holy Family Cathedral remains closed.

• Solidarity trial interim results show that hydroxychloroguine and lopinavir/ritonavir produce little or no reduction in mortality of hospitalized COVID-19 patients (see link below).

• WHO releases "WHO Academy" mobile application providing COVID-19 resources for health workers in 6 UN languages.
