HIGHLIGHTS

- Of the new cases, 549 (65.7%) are nationals.
- New infections by health area: Al Ahmadi (227), Al Jahra (195), Al Farwaniyah (175), Hawally (131) and Capital Area (108).
- The Ministry of Foreign Affairs: Work resumed at the two certification centres on Sunday 12 July.
- Kuwait Municipality registered 133 fines and 565 warnings to shops in Hawally Governorate during the month of June, they've also closed 18 shops due to failure to comply with mitigation measures.
- Up to 1.5 million expatriates may leave Kuwait by year-end due to economic slowdown.
- Kuwaiti Red Crescent distributes brochures, masks, sanitizers at Farwaniya educational area.
- Solidarity trial interim results show that hydroxychloroquine and lopinavir/ritonavir produce little or no reduction in mortality of hospitalized COVID-19 patients (see link below).
- WHO releases "WHO Academy" mobile application providing COVID-19 resources for health workers in 6 UN languages.
