



HIGHLIGHTS

- Of the new cases, 434 (61.7 %) are nationals.
- New infections by health area: Al Ahmadi (216), Al Jahra (180), Al Farwaniyah (159), Hawally (97) and Capital Area (51).
- Approximately 167,000 passengers have departed on 1,064 flights from Kuwait since mid-March until today.
- Kuwait University: The resumption of studies on the 9th of August via the distance education system.
- Plans to construct the Al-Dabdaba solar plant have been scraped as a result of COVID-19 pandemic.
- UN report forecasts increase in hunger and malnutrition globally as a result of COVID-19; in 2019 it was estimated that 690 million people went hungry, by the end of 2020 the number may increase by an additional 130 million (see link below).
- More than 150 countries engaged in COVID-19 vaccine global access facility, See link below.
