





HIGHLIGHTS

- Of the new cases 211 (70.3%) are citizens.
- Ministry of Interior: 26,224 residency violators departed from Kuwait.
- Ministry of Social Affairs: new application is launched in the name of "Kuwaitis without salary" to start receiving requests from citizens affected by the Corona pandemic.
- Industry Authority: Strategic accumulation of masks continues for 6 months, the daily production of local factories is estimated at more than 5 million masks daily.
- UN report forecasts increase in hunger and malnutrition globally as a result of COVID-19; in 2019 it was estimated that 690 million people went hungry, by the end of 2020 the number may increase by an additional 130 million (see link below).
