




## Meetings & Coordination




On 7th March 2022, The Primary & Secondary Healthcare Department and Directorate General of Health Services, Government of Punjab in collaboration with World Health Organization Pakistan conducted a National Experience Sharing Workshop on Dengue Control in Pakistan at Avari Hotel, Lahore. The event was chaired by Hon Provincial Minister for Health Punjab Prof. Dr Yasmin Rashid and graced by WHO Country Representative Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala, DG Health Punjab, Dr Haroon Jehangir Khan and Additional Secretary (VP) P&SHC Ms Maria Tariq. The objectives of the workshop were to share experiences and lessons learned from Dengue outbreak response in 2021 in the context of the COVID-19 Pandemic and develop recommendations for future response.

During his speech the WR praised Punjab Province for arranging this workshop. He reaffirmed WHO support to Dengue response. Dr Yasmine appreciates WHO Pakistan in supporting various activities including support to COVID-19 response.
