



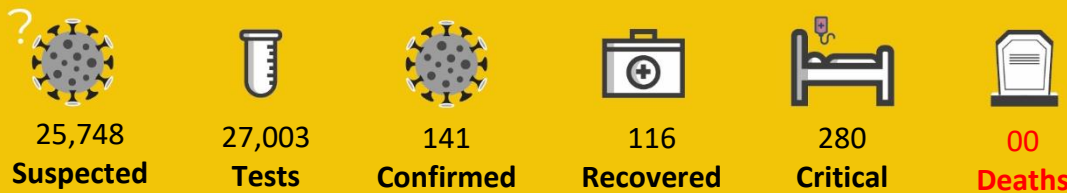

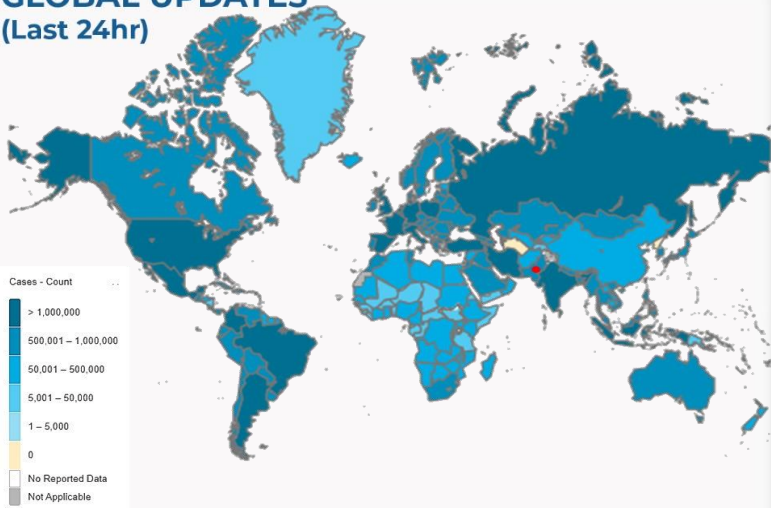

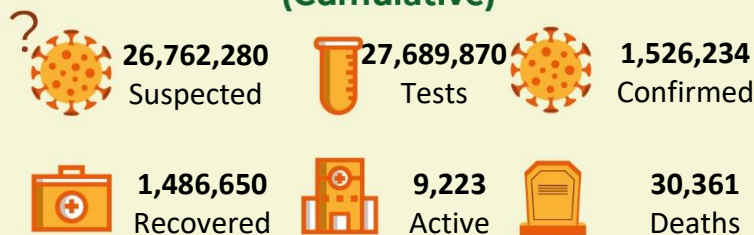
PAKISTAN SNAPSHOT (LAST 24hr)



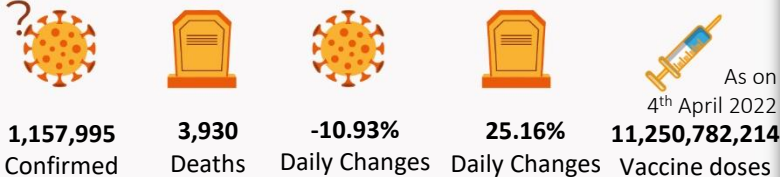
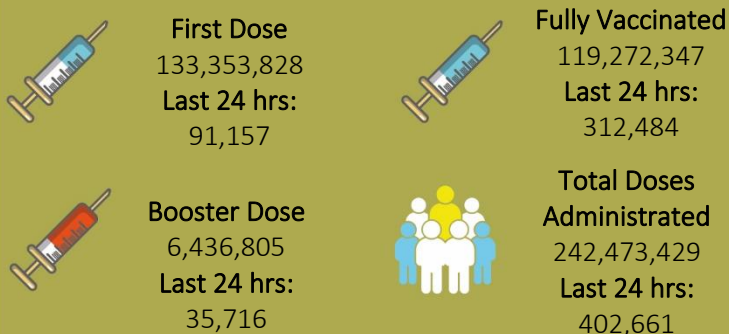

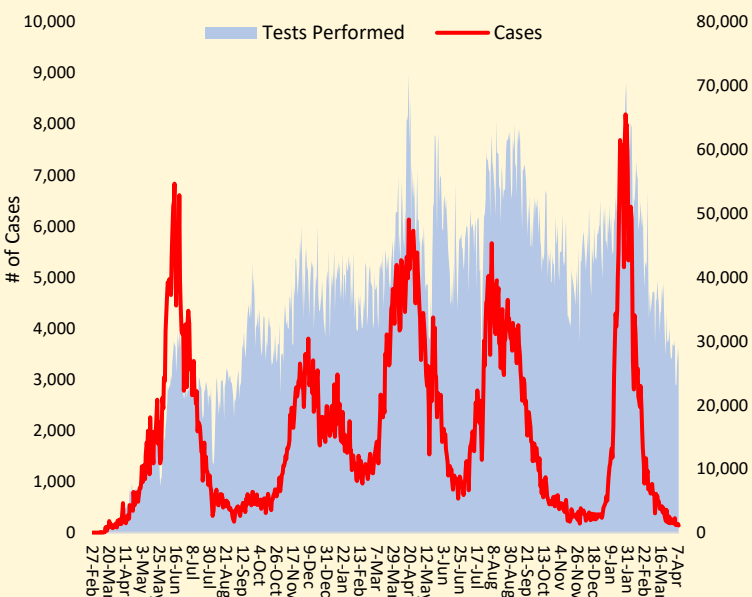
PAKISTAN COVID-19 SNAPSHOT (Cumulative)

Meetings & Coordination



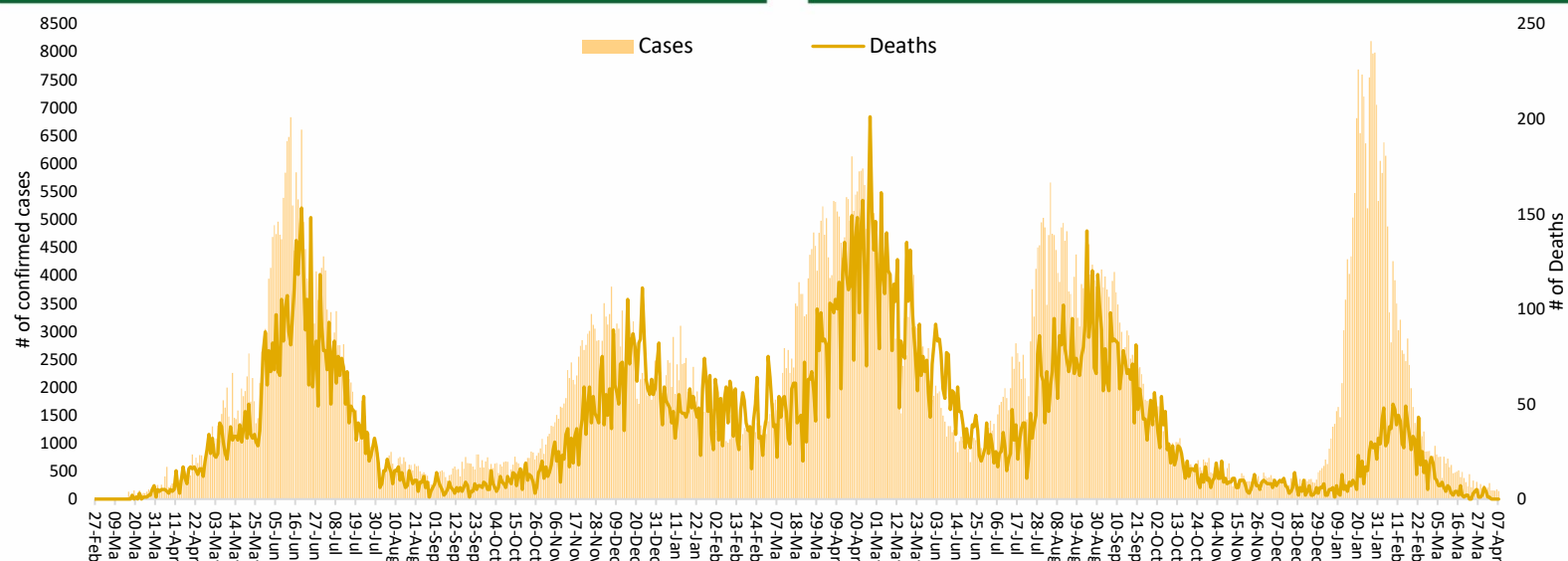

Daily Incidence and Deaths

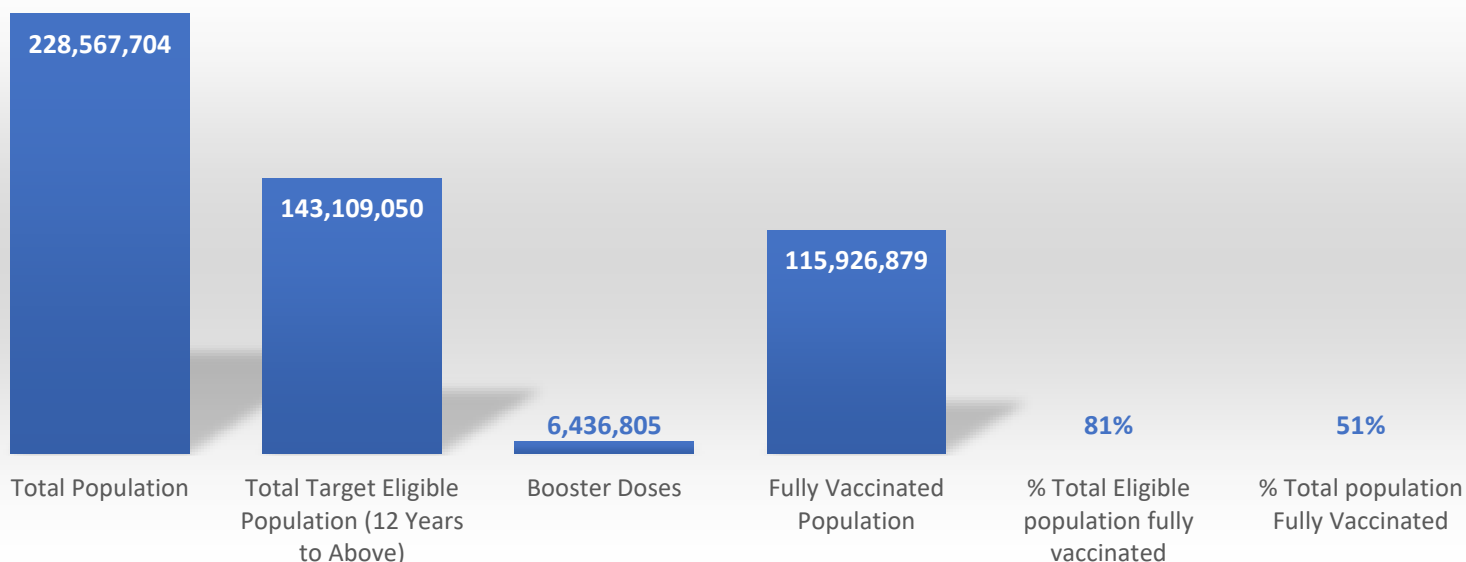

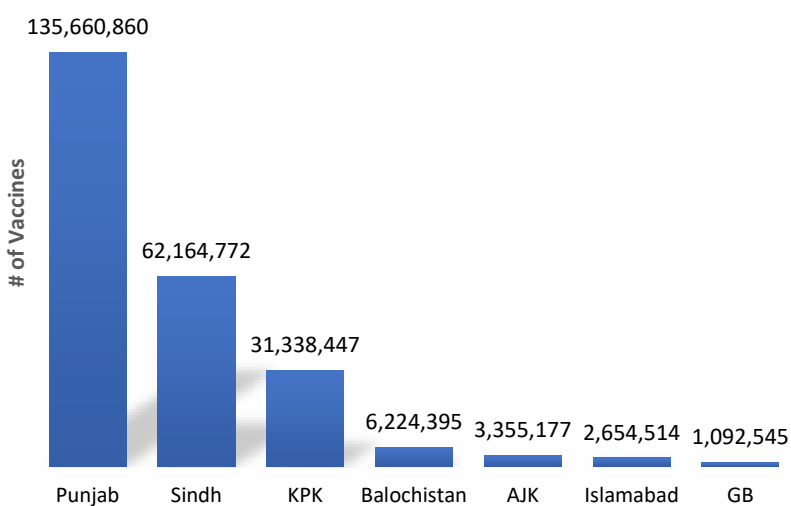

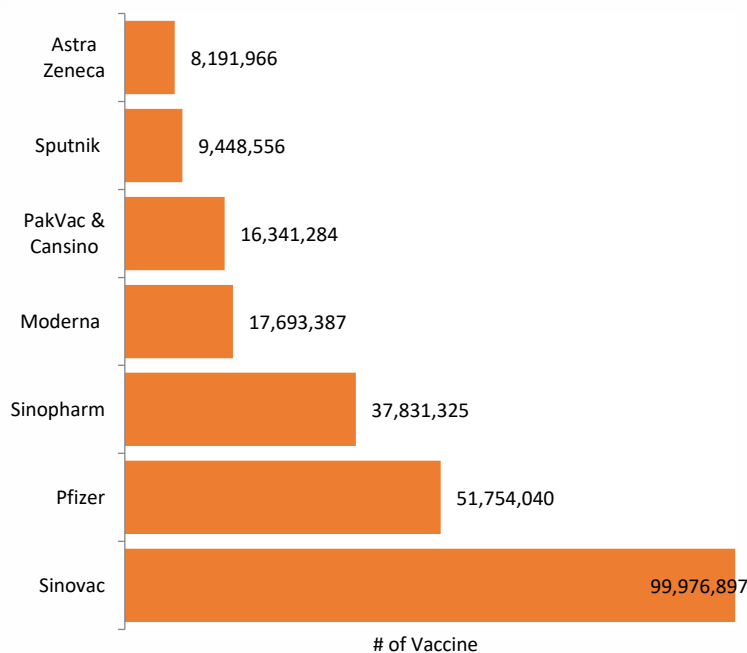
COVID-19 Vaccine Doses Analysis

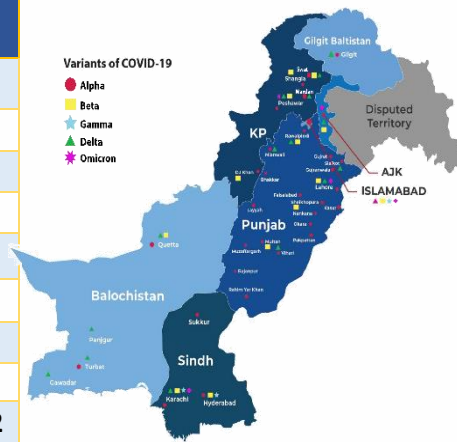
