





Summary Table by Province

On 8th March 2022, The Provincial TB Control Program, Primary & Secondary Healthcare Department Government of Punjab in collaboration with World Health Organization Pakistan conducted a 3-day Training for PMDT Physicians & Pharmacists on Updated National DR-TB & aDSM Guidelines at Hotel Four Points, Lahore. The WHO Country Representative Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala, Program Director TB Control Punjab Dr Sarmad Wahaj, Advisor DR-TB National TB Dr Ghafoor Ahmed, Advisor NRL NTP Dr Sabira Tahseen and Head of WHO Sub Office Dr Jamshaid Ahmed attended the opening session.

In his address, the WR highlighted that Pakistan contributes 70% of TB burden in WHO's EMRO and pledged WHO continued support to the government in the fight against TB. Dr Sarmad praised the WR and thanked WHO Pakistan for organizing the training.
