### PAKISTAN FLOODS SITUATION REPORT

Issue # 32: 12th May 2023



### **SITUATION OVERVIEW**

### Monitoring of Diseases Trend

- A total of 24,262 confirmed malaria cases have been reported in Pakistan in Epi week 18 of 2023, an increase of 3,597 cases as compared to 20,665 cases reported in Epiweek-17 of 2023.
- The monthly malaria test positivity rate has increased from 13% reported in March 2023 to 18% reported in April 2023, an increase of 5% however, no malaria outbreak situation is reported in the week. WHO is closely monitoring the trend.
- No new case of MPOX have been reported this week. The total number of MPOX cases reported in Pakistan is 3. All the 3 cases are imported.
- COVID-19 positivity rate in Pakistan in epi-week-19 of 2023 is 0.51% as compared to 1.37% in epi week 18 of 2023.
   Lahore and Rawalpindi are the districts reporting high number of cases.



### **WHO RESPONSE**

### • Support to RMNCH Services:

WHO Pakistan in collaboration with the Ministry of National Health Services Regulation and Coordination conducted a 3-day training of trainers on "care of small and sick newborns". The objective of the training was to train master trainers on the management of small and sick newborns. The trainees are expected to later train hospital teams from the newborn ICUs that were recently strengthened by WHO under the flood response. The participants included neonatologists and pediatricians from all four provinces and regions. The training took place in Lahore from 9-11 May 2023.

### • Support to response to malnutrition:

A total of 16,954 children have been treated in the 65 out of 80 WHO supported Nutrition Stabilization Centers (NSCs) in flood affected areas across Pakistan. This number is up from 16,104 children treated in epiweek 16 of 2023. The Performance indicators at the NSCs are 94.22% children cured, 4.55% defaulted and 1,23% died.

### • Support to EPI:

The WHO Country Representative in Pakistan, and Director General Federal Directorate of Immunization (FDI), inaugurated the newly constructed/refurbished health facility at Rawal Town. The health facility is in the peri-urban area of Islamabad and has a catchment population of about 50,000 people. The health facility is expected to offer general OPD services including routine immunization. WHO support included setup of a training hall with audio/video equipment, furniture for the training hall, donation of medicines and medical equipment, construction of children playground and perimeter wall for the health facility.


### **Dengue Fever in Pakistan** as of 11<sup>th</sup> May 2023
