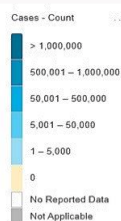
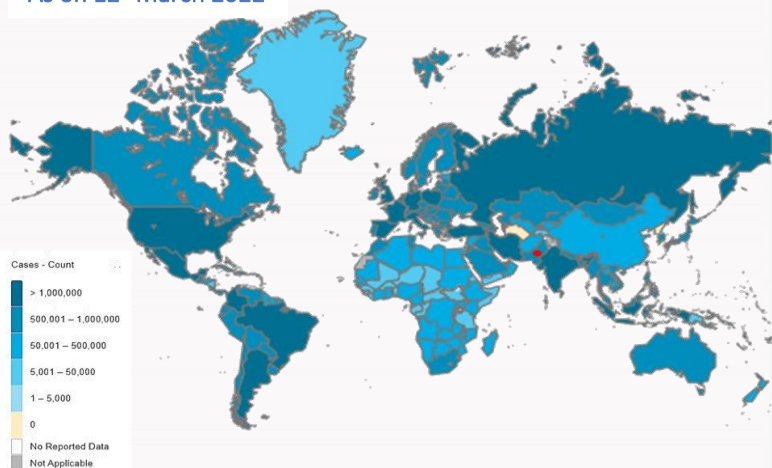

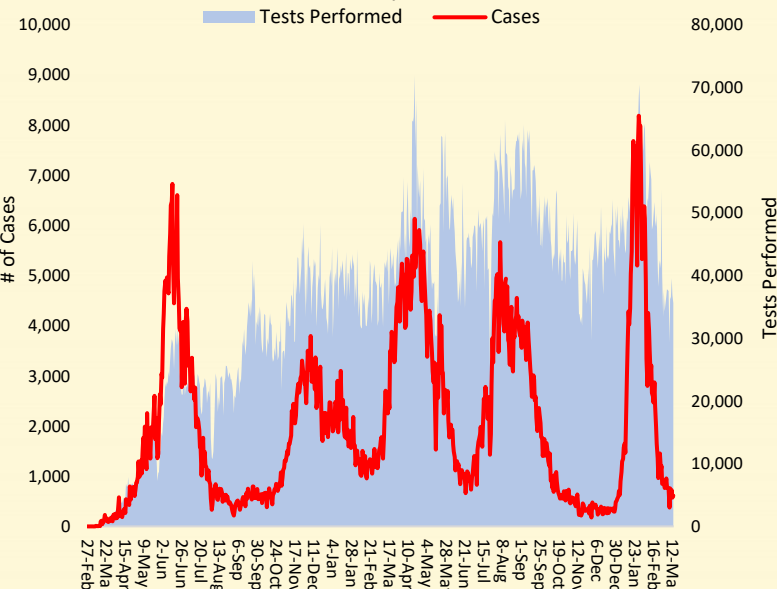

## Meetings & Coordination



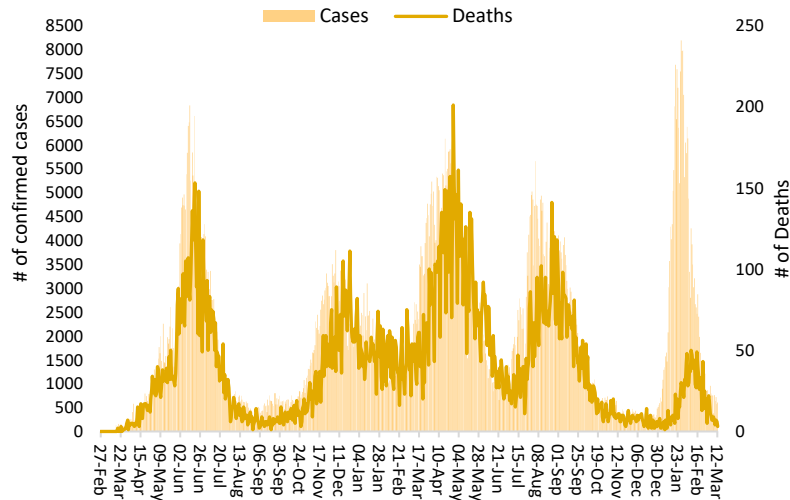
