On 16<sup>th</sup> February 2022, WHO Country Representative Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala met with the Secretary Health Azad Jammu and Kashmir (AJK), Major Gen. Ahsan Altaf Satti at his Office in Muzaffarabad. The Director General Health AJK Dr Sardar Aftab Hussain and senior officials of the department of Health AJK also attended the meeting.

Dr Palitha discussed the current COVID-19 situation globally, in the Eastern Mediterranean Region and in Pakistan with the secretary health. He emphasized on the "Wear a Mask Protect Pakistan" campaign to encourage the public to follow the COVID-19 prevention measures.

The Secretary Health AJK thanked Dr Palitha for his generous support and briefed him on the status, issues, and health needs of people living near the Line of Control (LoC) areas, the cardiac hospital at Muzaffarabad, and the government of AJK response to the COVID-19 pandemic.

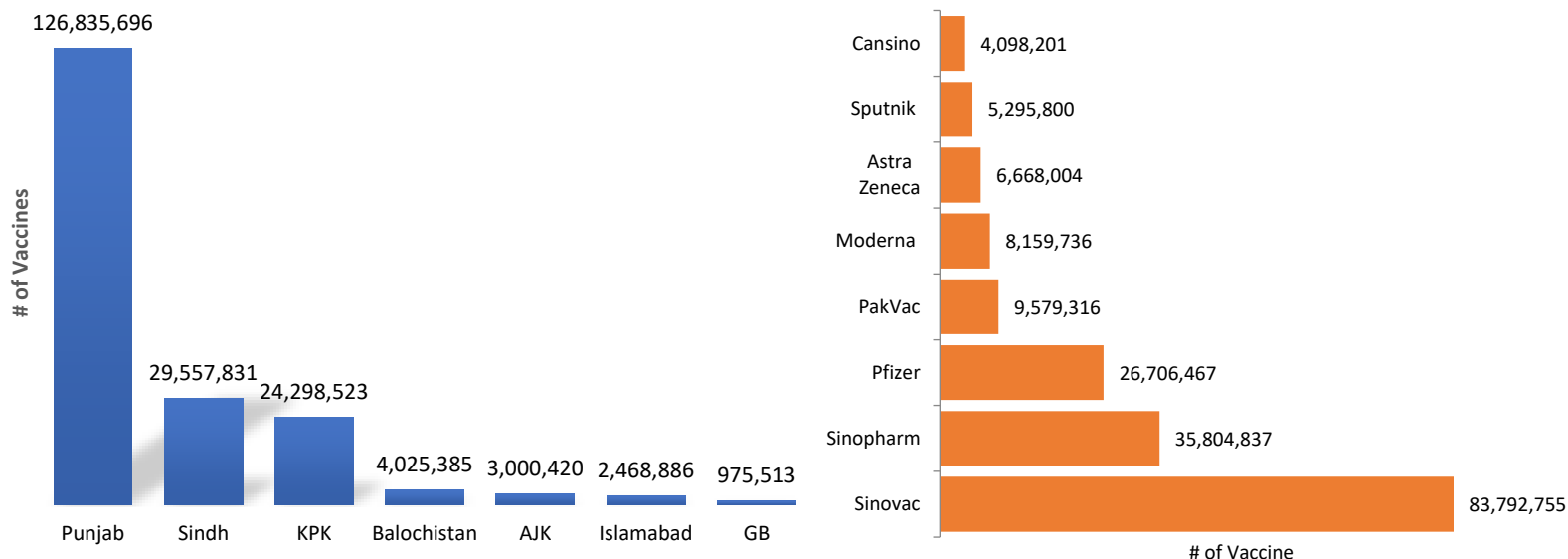

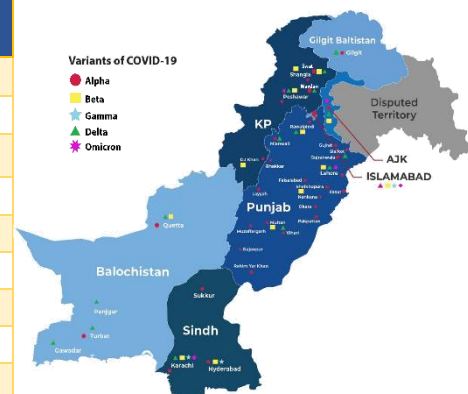
