

#### **Summary Table by Province**

On 18<sup>th</sup> December 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala met with the honorable Chief Minister Gilgit Baltistan (GB), Mr Khalid Khurshid at the Chief minister house Gilgit. Health Minister, Principal Secretary to Chief Minister and Additional Secretary Health GB were also present at the occasion. After the meeting WR handed over Cold Chain Equipped 4x4 vehicles and Mini Ambulances to the Chief Minister.

The COVID-19 situation and response in the region were discussed in the meeting. The chief minister expressed his concerns over the large number of young people suffering from cancer and stunting in some districts of GB and desired for WHO's special support. In his remarks, Dr. Palitha appreciated the Government of GB for the successful COVID-19 vaccination campaign in remote and extremely difficult areas. He also said that WHO would support to find out the causes of the two health problems which the CM has identified.

The Honorable Chief Minister appreciated the WHO support provided for improving the health of population in the region.
