

Positivity Rate by Major Cities/Districts



Summary Table by Province

On 18th March 2022, The WHO Country Representative Pakistan Dr. Palitha Mahipala visited Charsadda district, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and inaugurated the WHO supported open air gym at the charsadda sports complex. The ceremony was attended by the Additional Deputy Commissioner General Charsadda, Ms Saniya Safi, Additional Director General Health Services, KPK Dr Azmatullah Khan and the District Health Officer Charsadda Dr Farhad Khan. The establishment of an open-air gym is part of WHO support to the reduction of Non-Communicable Disease (diabetics and heart disease) and encouraging healthier lifestyle choices, discourage sedentary habits and tobacco use.

During his speech, the WR. stressed on the importance of replicating such high-impact interventions in other programs. Ms Saniya Safi thanked WR, Dr. Palitha, for his interest and support of health programs in Charsadda.
