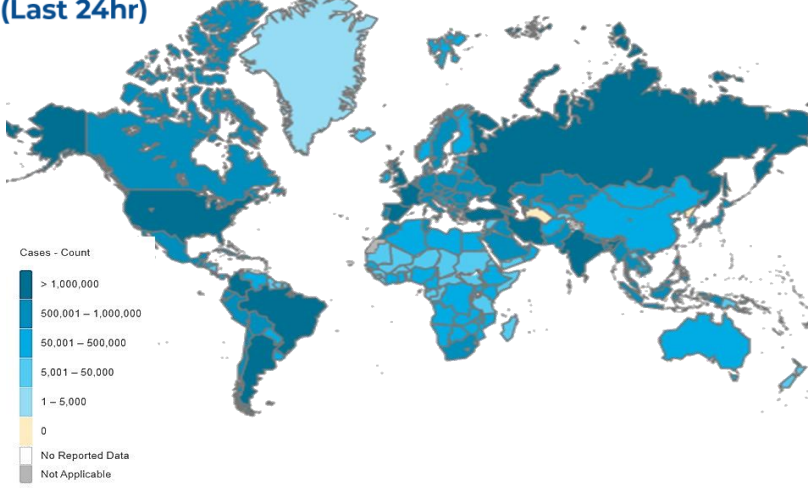
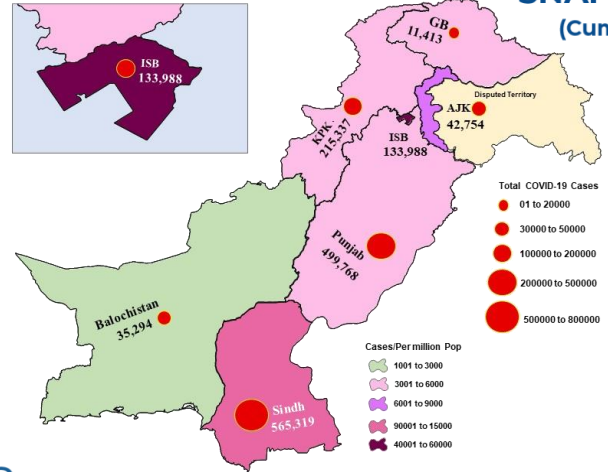

PAKISTAN COVID-19 SNAPSHOT (Cumulative)



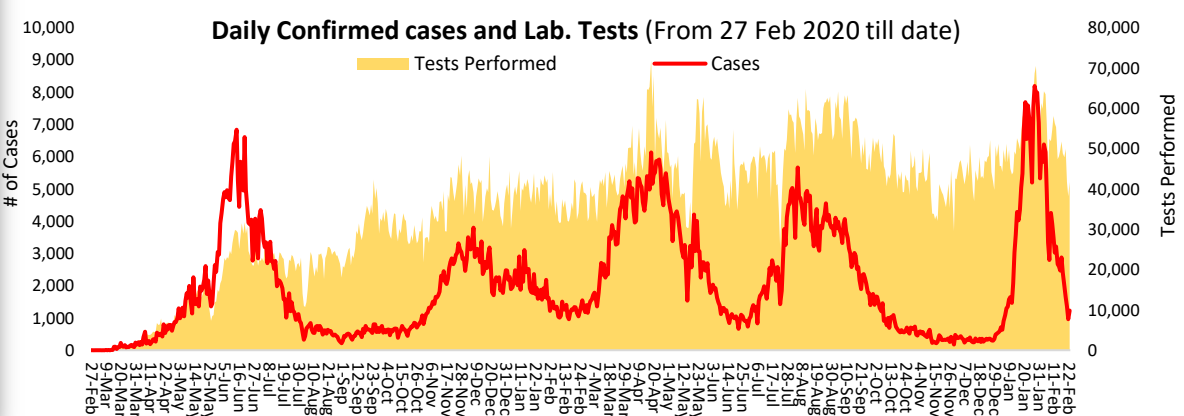
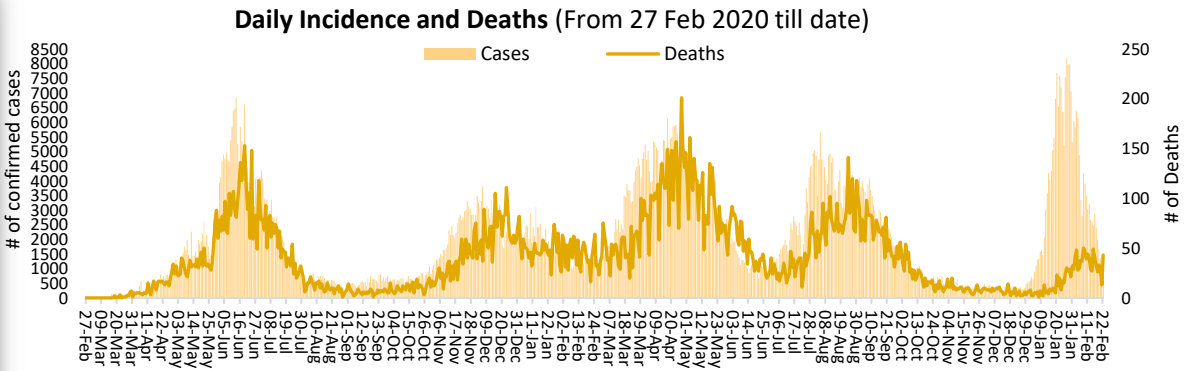

On 23rd February 2022, WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala and Executive Director National Institute of Health, Maj. Gen. Aamer Ikram jointly inaugurated the refurbished and upgraded National Influenza Centre (NIC) at National Institute of Health, Islamabad.

The WHO support included refurbishment of the cell culture and molecular testing laboratories at the NIC in line with latest biosafety and biosecurity requirements. As the apex public health laboratory and WHO designated National influenza Center in Pakistan since 1979; National Institute of Health Islamabad coordinates the laboratory surveillance of seasonal and pandemic influenza viruses. The NIC also serves as the national reference laboratory for emerging and re-emerging respiratory viral pathogens, including the response to the ongoing COVID19 pandemic.

In his remarks, Dr Palitha noted, "A prompt and definitive diagnosis is essential to outbreak response and preparedness for pandemics". Prof. Aamer appreciated the technical and logistic support from WHO to strengthen Pakistan's laboratory systems.
