Summary Table by Province

On 25th January 2022, WHO Country Office Pakistan held a virtual meeting with all WHO Sub-Offices. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the current upsurge of COVID-19 cases, particularly in high-risk districts of Pakistan. During the meeting, Public Health Surveillance Officer Dr Musa Rahim presented the National figure and then all WHO Sub-offices gave a brief presentation on the current situation of COVID-19 and the government response at provincial level. It was noted that the daily incidence and positivity ratio were showing upward trend since the beginning of January 2022. Implementation of public health measures among others to control further spread of the infection should be advocated for.

The meeting concluded by sharing national guidelines and SOPs for COVID-19 with the WHO sub-offices for use and further dissemination at all level.
