






On 22nd March 2022, The WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala officiated at the closing ceremony of a 6-week "Wear a Mask Campaign" and "Lahore get vaccinated Internship programme". The ceremony took place at Al-Humra Hall, Lahore. Other officials at the ceremony included the Commissioner Lahore, Capt. (R) Muhammad Usman Younis. During the ceremony, certificate of appreciation was awarded to 350 Volunteers, 24 Supervisors and 22 Staff who were engaged in the campaign. Speaking at the ceremony, Muhammad Usman thanked Dr Palitha and acknowledged WHO Pakistan's support.




