On 22<sup>nd</sup> December 2021, Ministry of National Health Services Regulations and Coordination, Nutrition Wing in collaboration with World Health Organization Pakistan conducted a workshop at Health Services Academy (HSA) Islamabad. Special Assistant to Prime Minister on Health, Dr Faisal Sultan graced the inaugural session. Other dignitaries attended the inaugural session included Parliamentary Secretary for Health Dr Nausheen Hamid, Secretary Health Mr Ashraf Khawaja, Vice Chancellor HSA Dr Shahzad Ali Khan, Director Regulations & Nutrition Dr Baseer Achakzai and Dr Sabeen Afzal Deputy Director Programs.

Objective of the workshop was to conduct a situation assessment to evaluate the highest priority nutritional problems faced in Pakistan through life course approach. The workshop participants included representatives of the provincial health departments, UN organization, INGOs, academia and Researchers.

Dr Baseer Achakzai appreciated the WHO support and work of the Health Services Academy for development of the action framework.

Dr Faisal Sultan emphasized the importance of Nutrition as a cornerstone intervention to improve health of the people of Pakistan and pledged his support for fighting the malnutrition in Pakistan.
