

CURRENT EPIDEMIOLOGY OF POLIO IN PAKISTAN

As of 19th February 2015, 306 type-1 wild poliovirus (WPV) cases have been reported in year 2014 from 44 districts/ towns/ tribal agencies/ FR areas (compared to 93 in 2013 from 23 districts/ towns/ tribal agencies/ FR areas). Moreover, WPV-1 has also been isolated from 131 environmental samples in 2014 (out of 372 samples for which results are available) from Karachi (Gadap, Baldia and Gulshan-e-Iqbal towns), Hyderabad, Sukkur and Jacobabad in Sindh; Peshawar and D.I Khan in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa; Lahore, Rawalpindi and Multan in Punjab and Quetta and Killa Abdullah in Balochistan. Twenty one sabin-2 like poliovirus cases have been reported in 2014 including 17 from FATA (eight from FR Bannu, seven from North Waziristan agency and two from Khyber agency), three from Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (one each from Bannu, Lakki Marwat and Peshawar) and one from Sindh (Gadap town Karachi).

A total of nine wild polio virus cases have been confirmed with date of onset of paralysis in 2015; five from Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (two from Peshawar and one each from Tank, Lakki Marwat and Nowshera districts), three from FATA (two from Khyber agency and one from South Waziristan agency) and one from Sindh (Kambar district). Moreover, WPV-1 has also been isolated from 13 environmental samples in 2015 (out of 33 samples for which results are available) from Karachi (Baldia, Gadap and Gulshan-e-Iqbal towns), Sukkur and Jacobabad in Sindh; Quetta and Killa Abdullah in Balochistan; Peshawar in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa; Lahore in Punjab; and Islamabad.

Following are the key epidemiological characteristics of polio cases reported in 2014:

- 256 (83.6%) polio cases are younger than two years (median age: 14 months).
- Based on recall of parents, 171 (55.9%) cases did not receive any OPV dose (through routine vaccination and/or campaigns); 73 (23.8%) cases received 1-3 OPV doses, 26 (8.5%) received 4-6 doses; while 36 (11.7%) polio cases received 7 or more OPV doses.

It is worth mentioning that, 81.7% (247/306) wild polio cases in 2014 have been reported together from Khyber Pakhtunkhwa 22.2% (68/306) and FATA 58.5% (179/306) indicating that these regions remained the key polio reservoirs in the country. North and South Waziristan agencies reported 30.7% (94/306) while Khyber agency alone reported 24.8% (76/306) of the total wild polio cases in 2014. Peshawar contributed 42.6% (29/68) of the total wild polio cases reported in 2014 from Khyber Pakhtunkhwa; whereas Karachi contributed 76.6% (23/30) of wild polio cases from Sindh province in 2014.

Other districts/ towns/ tribal agencies/ FR areas where the significant number of wild polio cases have been reported in year 2014 includes nine cases from FR Bannu in FATA; 11 cases from Bannu, seven from Tank and five from Mardan district in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa; 13 cases from Killa Abdulla and five from Quetta district in Balochistan.


- A technical consultation meeting was convened on 14-15 February in Islamabad to review the current situation and status of implementation of the low transmission season plans in the country.
- A vaccination campaign (as per Short Interval targeting 8 million children in 62 selected districts was conducted in first week of Feb 2015. The activity was completed in all except Zhob (Balochistan), two UCs of D.I.Khan (KP) and Bara Tehsil of Khyber (FATA) due to security reasons.



WPV-1 has been isolated from 35% of the sewage water samples collected from 36 sites of 15 districts / towns across the country in 2014. More than 50% of the environmental samples collected from Karachi, Hyderabad, Sukkur and Jacobabad districts in Sindh; Peshawar district in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and Killa Abdullah district in Balochistan were positive for wild polio virus. No sample has been turned positive for WPV from Islamabad in 2014, while the environmental samples collected from Faisalabad district in Punjab have been continuously negative since February 2013.

AN UPDATE ON FEB 2015 NIDs

The February 2015 National Immunization Days (NIDs) have been completed across the country, targeting around 34.2 million children with bivalent Oral Polio Vaccine (bOPV). Some areas of northern part of the country could not be reached due to heavy snow fall, therefore vaccination campaign had to be canceled in those places. Snow bound areas include; 14 UCs of Chitral district and 4 UCs of Mansehra district in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa; 3 UCs of Sakardu district in Gilgit Baltistan and 3 UCs of Neelum district in AJK. The campaign could not be conducted in Zhob and Shirani districts of Balochistan due to security concerns. In all 18 towns of Karachi, NID was canceled and a special plan made to cover target children in a three phased weekly campaigns based on set priorities. In total; around 35 million children (101% of the target population up to the age of 5 years) have been reportedly vaccinated across the country in Feb 2015 NIDs.

A total of 235 lots were assessed through Lot Quality Assurance Sampling (LQAS) after the February 2015 NIDs; of which 167 (71.1%) were of passed quality. Forty-six (19.5%) Lots were of intermediate quality from 29 districts/ towns/ tribal agencies/ FR areas including seven districts of Balochistan, eight of Sindh, four districts of Punjab and 10 of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa. Out of 22 LQAS Lots that were of failed quality; 16 (72.7%) were from Balochistan including 10 from Quetta district and three each from Pishin and Killa Abdullah districts. Other districts, where the Lots were failed includes three (13.6%) from Peshawar and one each from Malakand and Swat districts in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and one from Rawalpindi district in Punjab.

More than 93% children were found finger marked through Spot survey at national and provincial levels except in Balochistan (83%). Districts/ towns/ agencies/ FR areas with sub optimal performance includes Layari town (62%), Malir town (79%), Jamshed town (82%), Korangi town (84%), Gadap town (85%), Shah Faisal town (86%), North Nazimabad town (88%) and Kemari town (89%) in Karachi, Sindh; districts Astore (89%) in Gilgit Baltistan; and districts Pishin (71%), Killa Abdullah (75%), Sibi (79%) and Chaghi (85%) in Balochistan.



Key AFP Surveillance Indicators 2014

Overall AFP surveillance indicators in year 2014 were above the international standards at the national level as well as in major provinces and majority of districts, towns and tribal agencies (data on pages 3-8).

At the national level the annualized non polio AFP rate for 2014 was 6.08 per 100,000 children below 15 years of age. All provinces and regions except Gilgit Baltistan had the required rate of 2 or above. The indicator was also above the international standards in 88.3% (144/163) of the districts/towns/agencies (map-3). Majority of districts with sub-optimal non-polio AFP rate have small populations and hence low number of expected AFP cases. However, Orangi, Saddar, North Karachi, Korangi and Layari towns in Karachi, Kotli in AJK and CDA in Islamabad have significant number of expected cases. Seventy eight percent of the districts/towns/agencies (124/159) which reported AFP cases had adequate stool specimen collection rate above the international standard of 80%.

All the districts/ towns/ agencies/ areas with sub-optimal surveillance indicators especially those which have persistent low indicators need to review their AFP surveillance system for the causes of low performance and take corrective actions accordingly. Actions to improve the situation and maintaining the status in well performing districts should be part of the district specific plan and should be regularly reviewed.



The first National Immunization Days (NIDs) of 2015 have been completed in all planned 163 districts/ towns/ tribal agencies/ FR areas across the country, targeting around 35.5 million children with bivalent Oral Polio Vaccine (bOPV). Punjab has preponed the NIDs and started vaccination activities from 2nd week of January in all districts due to a scheduled Measles campaign in the 3rd week. The vaccination activities were delayed due to heavy snow fall in two UCs of Skardu in Gilgit Baltistan; three UCs of Mansehra and 10 UCs of Chitral districts in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa. The campaign was also delayed in Zhob, Loralai, Musakhel and Killa Saifullah districts in Balochistan; 36 UCs of Mansehra and tehsil Allai of Batagram district in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa for better security arrangements. In Karachi the campaign has been conducted in three phases. More than 36.1 million children (102% of the target population up to the age of 5 years) have been reportedly vaccinated across the country in Jan 2015 NIDs.

A total of 252 lots were assessed through Lot Quality Assurance Sampling (LQAS) after the January NIDs; of which 159 (63%) were of passed quality. Seventy-four (29%) Lots were of intermediate quality from 46 districts/ towns/ tribal agencies/ FR areas including 19 district of Sindh, 13 of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, six districts each of Balochistan and Punjab, and two of Islamabad. Out of 19 Lots that were of failed quality; seven (36.8%) were from Khyber Pakhtunkhwa province (three in Peshawar and one each in Charsada, Swabi, Buner and Lakki Marwat districts) and seven (36.8%) were from Sindh province (four from Karachi (one each from Jamshed, Kemari, Korangi and Liaqatabad towns), two from Shikarpur and one from Kambar districts). Other districts where the LQAS Lots were failed includes two in Quetta and one each in Pishin and Sherani districts in Balochistan province and one in ICT of Federal Capital Islamabad. It is important to mention that no LQAS has been conducted in AJK, FATA and Gilgit Baltistan.

Market Survey results showed sub optimal performance in Mastung (73%), Chaghi and Killa Abdullah (81%) in Balochistan; FR Bannu (84%), FR Peshawar and Mohamand agency (88%) in FATA; and Peshawar (86%), Swabi (87%), Nowshera (88%), Mardan and Tank (89%) in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa. The sub-optimal vaccination quality in critical districts/ agencies of reservoir regions in FATA, central Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Balochistan and the high risk towns in Karachi is of serious concern. It is important to ensure the highest campaign quality in polio reservoirs to stop the viral circulation. At the mean time quality maintenance is also important in areas without polio cases and endemic poliovirus circulation to avert the risk of viral introduction.
