



INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE




TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.




Pakistan reported **2,463** new cases of COVID-19 on **31 December 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **482,178** with **10,176** deaths **(CFR: 2.11%)**. Out of the total **34,773** currently active cases **2,693** cases are hospitalized.

MEETINGS & COORDINATION

On 1st January 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr. Palitha Mahipala celebrated the new year event with the WHO country office essential staff at WCO. While talking to the staff at occasion, WR recalled sequence of events during 2020 in context of COVID-19 pandemic.

Dr Palitha recapped the start of the pandemic one year ago, and its swift global spread. He also summarized how effectively the WHO, scientific community and partners reacted to the pandemic emergency. The diagnostic tests were deployed quickly, and genetic sequencing data was available within days, technical guidelines were developed for immediate response with innovative developments for the treatment of COVID-19, and in less than a year various vaccine options were available for use. He said that these are some of the extraordinary achievements in such a short time and WHO at all levels played its role to guide and mobilize the global community for pandemic response. The WR also highlighted the WHO country Office Pakistan contribution and support to the country for the COVID-19 pandemic response.
