

## WHO Pakistan in collaboration with Ministry of National Health Services, Regulations and Coordination (MNHSRC), Sehat Sahulat Program (SSP) conducted a two-day training (31st July – 1 Aug 2021) for general practitioners on Essential Package of Health Services (EPHS) specially designed for the Out-Patient Department (OPD) Health Insurance Pilot Project. The pilot project will be implemented at primary health care in selected health facilities of Islamabad. The purpose of the training was to develop capacity of the service providers on the modified outpatient Essential Package of Health Services for the pilot OPD health insurance project. In his remarks, the Director Sehat Sahulat Program in MNHSR&C Mr. Arshad applauded WHO for the continuous support to MoNHSR&C to ensure that the outpatient Health Insurance programme is launched. He noted that this programme will support poor families access selected outpatient health services through capitation model. He argued participants to put in practice what they have learnt.
