




Executive Summary

Pakistan reported **543** new cases of COVID-19 on **30 September 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **312,806** with **6,484** deaths **(CFR: 2.07%)**. Out of the total **8,825** currently active cases, **708** cases are hospitalized, out of which **490 (69.21%)** are in critical condition. **8,117** COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or in-home isolation. A total of **297,497 (95.11%)** have recovered and discharged.


Daily Incidence/Mortality




Daily COVID-19 Positivity Rate




Daily COVID-19 Global Updates




Daily Incidence by Province


Meetings & Coordination
