

Summary Table by Province

On 1st November 2021, National Programme Manager EPI, Dr Akram Shah, paid a courtesy visit to the WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala at the WHO country office, Islamabad. During the meeting, Dr Akram briefed the WR on the progress of the preparations for the upcoming Measles and Rubella (MR) country wide vaccination campaign that is scheduled to take place from the 15th November 2021 to 2nd December 2021. The campaign targets 91 million children aged 9 months to 15 years in Pakistan.

Dr Palitha updated Dr. Akram of the bilateral advocacy meetings between WHO and the federal and provincial governments to ensure successful implementation of the MR campaign. Dr Akram appreciated WHOs technical and logistical support towards the campaign especially, the preparation of the micro plans; human resources support and capacity building for health workers.
