



INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE




TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.




Pakistan reported 2,184 new cases of COVID-19 on 01 January 2021. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is 484,362 with 10,258 deaths (CFR: 2.12%). Out of the total 35,130 currently active cases 2,745 cases are hospitalized.

MEETINGS & COORDINATION

The World Health Organization Pakistan in collaboration with Directorate of Epidemic Prevention and Control (EPC), Department of Health Punjab, conducted the second one day training for SARI/ILI sentinel site focal persons on 21st December 2020. The training was conducted at Directorate General of Health Services Punjab Lahore. Seventeen (17) focal persons from the Primary & Secondary health care Department and Specialized Healthcare & Medical Education Department stationed at identified sentinel sites in high COVID-19 burden districts across Punjab were trained.
