


PAKISTAN COVID-19 SITUATION REPORT

Monday, 2nd August 2021 (1 year & 158 Days)



Meetings & Coordination







WHO supported Balochistan provincial health department in COVID 19 case investigation and response from 16/07/21 to 1/08/21. This was in response to an upsurge of the COVID-19 cases in Makran division. During the field mission, the team undertook epidemiological investigation of cases and trained the responders in Test Trace and Quarantine techniques, infection control and prevention (IPC), case management and strengthening laboratory testing.

On 2/8/2021, a debriefing meeting was held in Quetta and attended by Provincial Secretary Health, Mr Aziz Jamali, the DGHS,Dr Nasir Ali Bugti and COVID-19 Operational Cell Incharge, Dr Ghulam Mustafa. The meeting discussed the challenges in the response, action taken and the way forward to sustain the interventions set in motion by the team. The Hon. secretary health Balochistan, appreciated WHO Pakistan for the health system strengthening approach to the COVID 19 response and further pledged to implement the recommendations of the WHO mission.
