




Executive Summary

Pakistan reported **625** new cases of COVID-19 on **01 October 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **313,431** with **6,499** deaths **(CFR: 2.07%)**. Out of the total **8,877** currently active cases, **720** cases are hospitalized, out of which **480 (66.66%)** are in critical condition. **8,157** COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or in-home isolation. A total of **298,055 (95.09%)** have recovered and discharged.


Daily Incidence/Mortality




Daily COVID-19 Positivity Rate






Daily Incidence by Province



Daily Lab Test conducted




COVID-19 Positivity rates by Province
