### Summary Table by Province

The handover ceremony took place at WHO Country Office Islamabad.

The Director General Health, Metropolitan Corporation, Islamabad and District Health Officer ICT, expressed their appreciation for WHO Pakistan support to the upsurge in Dengue fever in ICT.
