



INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE




TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.




Pakistan reported **2,829** new cases of COVID-19 on **01 December 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **403,311** with **8,166** deaths **(CFR: 2.02%)**. Out of the total **49,780** currently active cases, **2,810** cases are hospitalized.

MEETINGS & COORDINATION

Today 2nd December 2020, World Health Organization Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala donated 3 Double Cabin vehicles to the DG MNHSR&C, Dr Malik Muhammad Safi to strengthen COVID-19 response in Islamabad Capital Territory.
