On 1<sup>st</sup> December 2021, World Health Organization Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala along with WHO Pakistan staff participated in an awareness walk to commemorate the World AIDS Day. The Parliamentary Secretary for Health Dr Nausheen Hamid and Deputy National Coordinator, Common Management Unit, HIV, TB, and Malaria Dr. Ayesha Isani Majeed graced the event. The World AIDS Day 2021 is being commemorated under the theme “End inequalities. End AIDS”.

In his brief remarks, Dr Palitha emphasized on the need to increase the HIV testing coverage and link HIV positive cases to health care. During the occasion, the updated HIV Treatment Guidelines were launched.

Dr Nausheen appreciated WHO Pakistan for supporting the awareness walk and stressed on the need to scale up prevention efforts to curtail on new HIV infections in the country.
