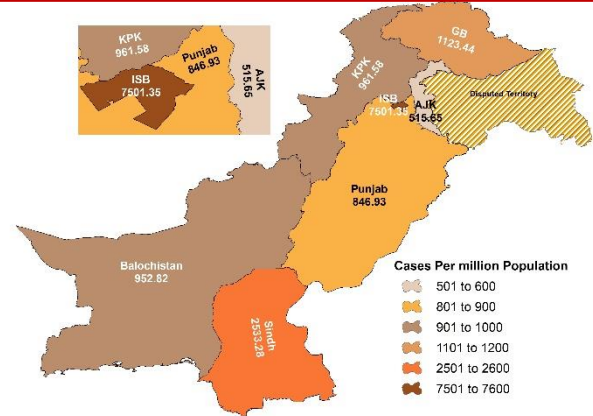

### COVID-19 case density/million Population

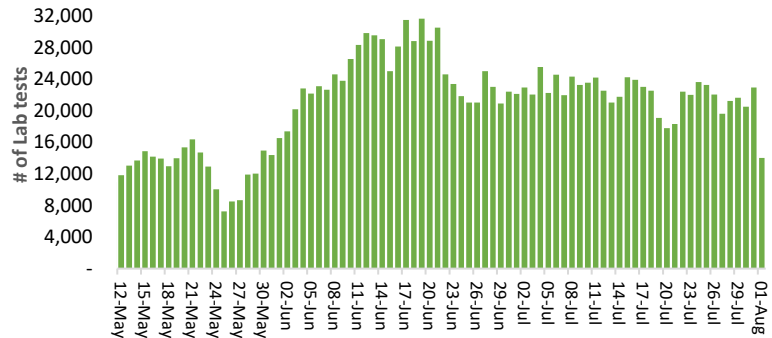


### Executive Summary

Pakistan reported **553** new cases of COVID-19 on **01 August 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **279,699** with **5,976** deaths (**CFR: 2.13%**). Out of the total **25,146** currently active cases, **1,618** cases are hospitalized, out of which **1,064 (65.76%)** are in critical condition. **23,528** COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or in-home isolation. A total of **248,577 (88.87%)** have recovered and discharged.

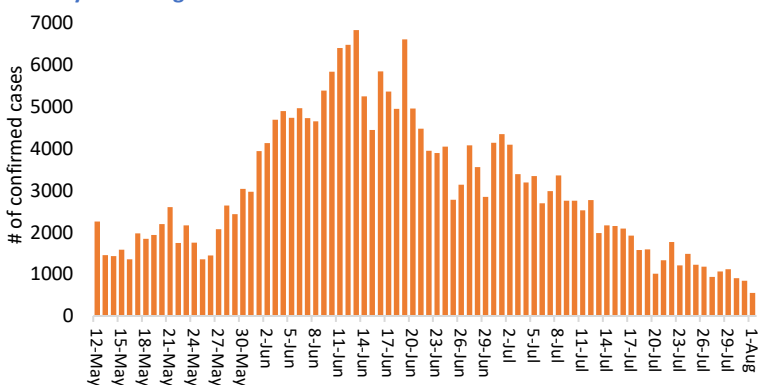
### Daily Lab tests conducted in Pakistan

10 May to 01 Aug 2020



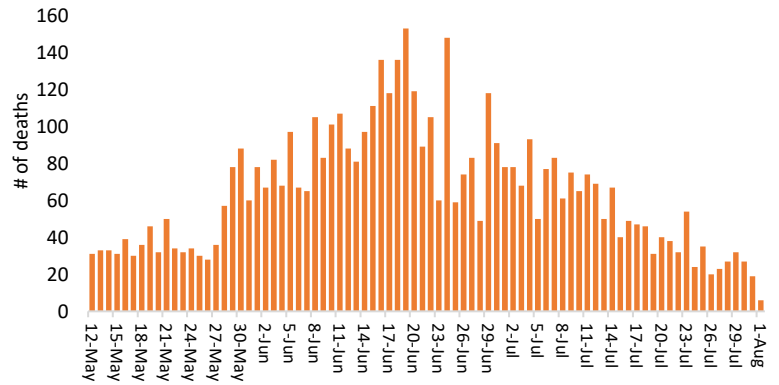
### Daily incidence of COVID-19 cases in Pakistan

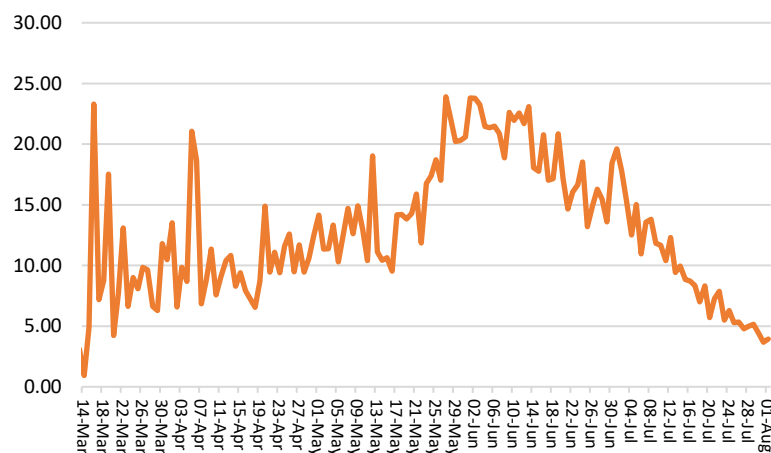


## Meeting & Coordination

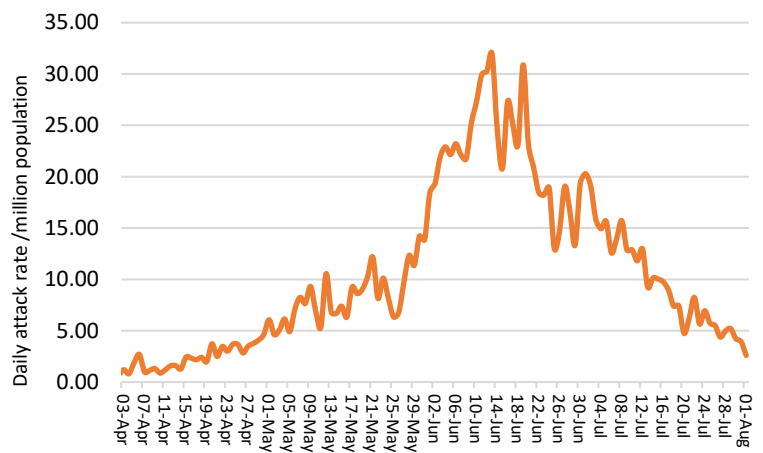

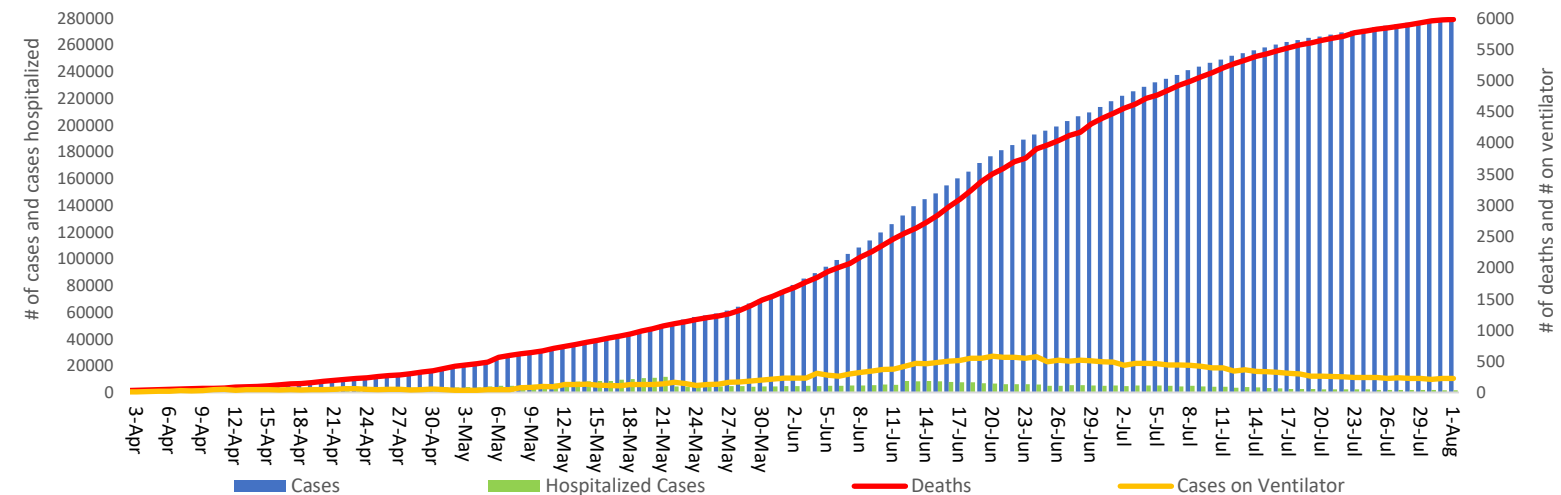
## Daily Positivity rate in Pakistan



## Daily Attack rate/million population



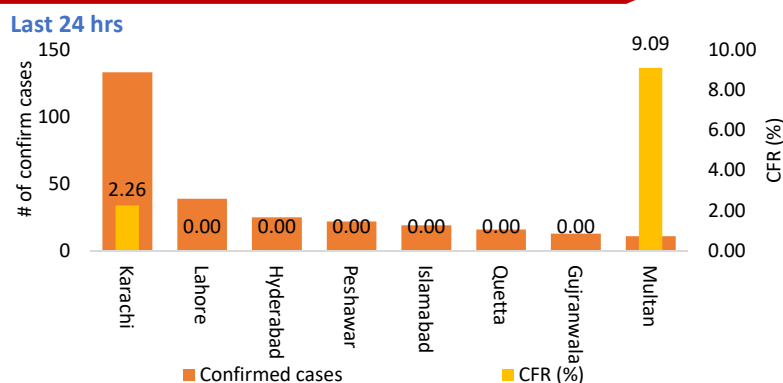
## Trends of COVID-19 cases, hospitalized, on ventilator & Deaths



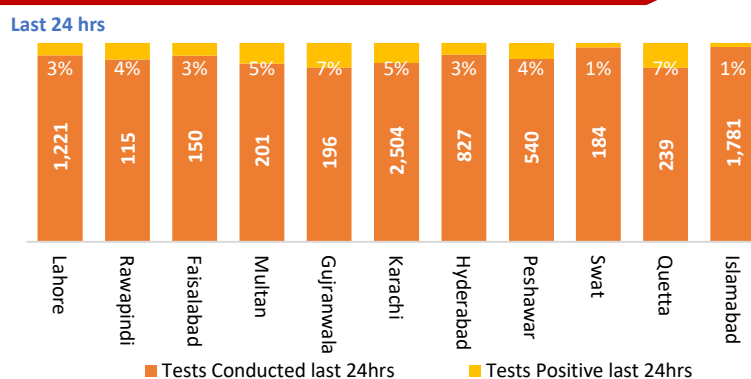

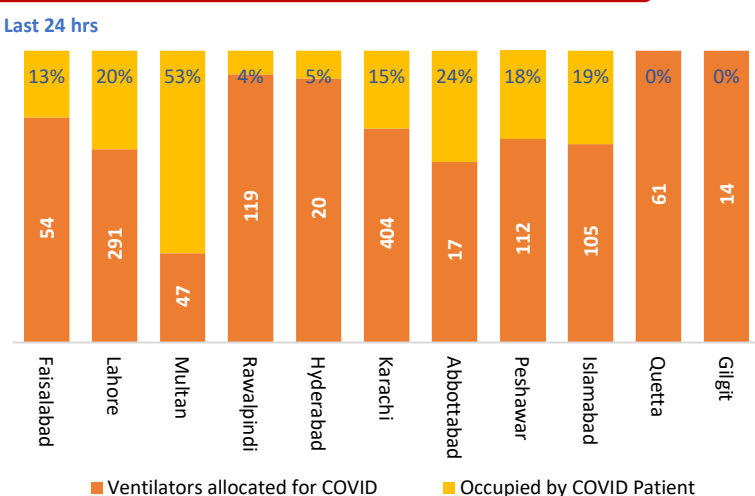
## COVID-19 confirmed cases & CFR (%) by districts
