


INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE



Pakistan reported 2,272 new cases of COVID-19 on 02 January 2021. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is 486,634 with 10,311 deaths (CFR: 2.12%). Out of the total 35,663 currently active cases 2,773 cases are hospitalized.
