





INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE




TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.




Pakistan reported **1,384** new cases of COVID-19 on **2nd February 2021**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **549,032** with **11,802** deaths **(CFR: 2.15%)**. Out of the total **33,184** currently active cases **2,470** cases are hospitalized.

SUMMARY TABLE BY PROVINCE

MEETINGS & COORDINATION

The national immunization drive against COVID-19 was simultaneously inaugurated today Wednesday 3rd February 2021 in all the provinces in Pakistan including AJK and Gilgit Baltistan. The Minister for Planning and Development Assad Umar in Chair flanked by National Coordinator NCOC Lt. Gen Hamood Uz Zaman Khan officiated the inauguration in a special ceremony at NCOC Islamabad while the chief ministers of all provinces, including Gilgit Baltistan, Azad Kashmir Prime Minister and the Officer In Charge WHO Pakistan participated through video link. Pakistan on Monday (1st Feb 2021) received first batch of 0.5 million doses of Sinopharm vaccine. The vaccine is being administered to the frontline healthcare workers. According to the National Command and Operation Center (NCOC), the first batch of COVID-19 vaccine has reached all the Federating units. WHO is supporting the government to implement the National Deployment and Vaccination Plan for COVID-19.
