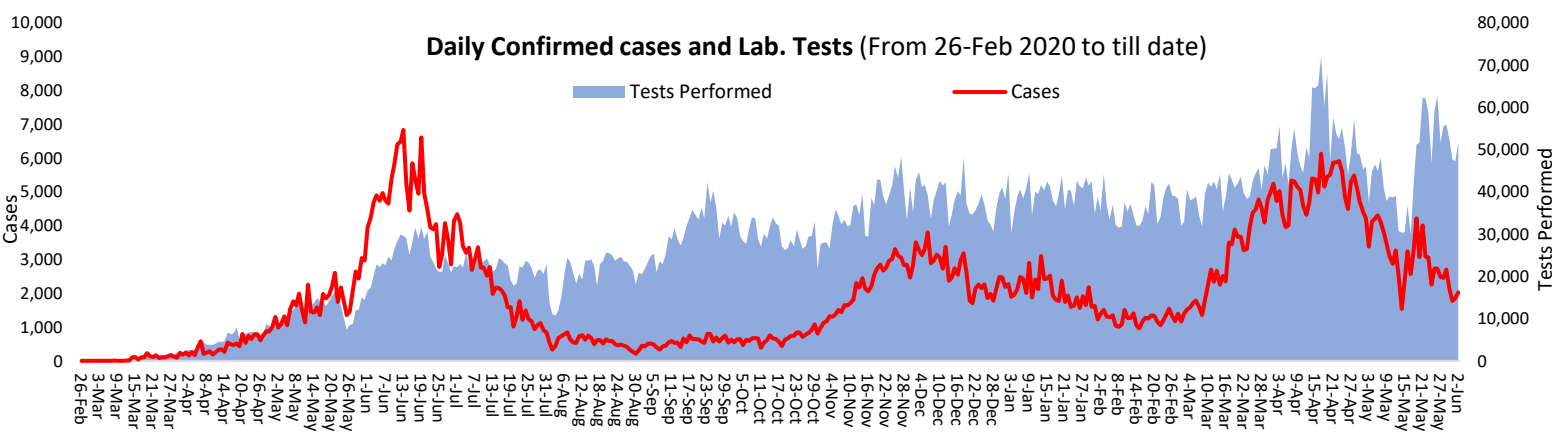

Meeting and Coordination



On 3rd June 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala handed over IT equipment to Pakistan Integrated Regulatory Information Management System (PIRIMS) at Drug Regulatory Authority of Pakistan (DRAP), Headquarter Islamabad. Secretary Health, Ministry of National Health Services, Regulations and Coordination, Mr Amir Ashraf Khawaja, and Chief Executive Officer (DRAP) Dr Asim Rauf were present on the occasion.

The purpose of the donation is to support strengthening DRAP as robust national regulatory authority in the regions and improve functionality of viflow reporting on AEFIs.

Dr Palitha said that this is another step to move together and reiterate WHO's commitment as trusted partners in DRAP strategic road map for expanding access to effective treatments. He said that regulatory systems stewardship is crucial in combatting the current pandemic and facilitating systematic preparedness and response to public health threats and infectious disease hazards under IHR-2005.
