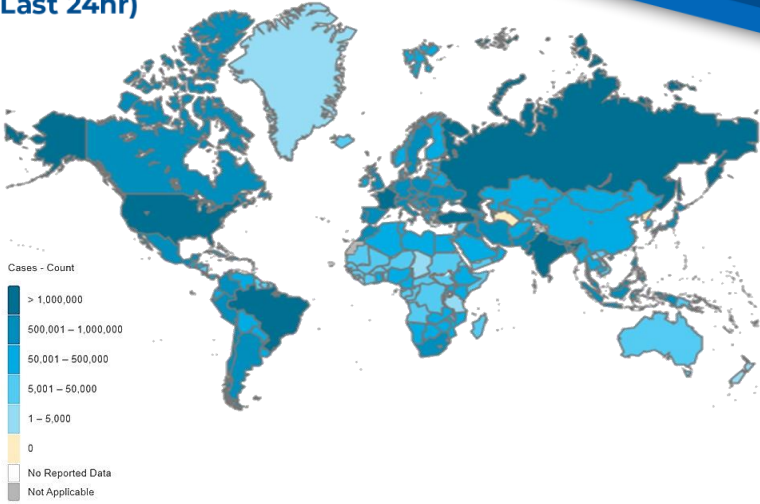


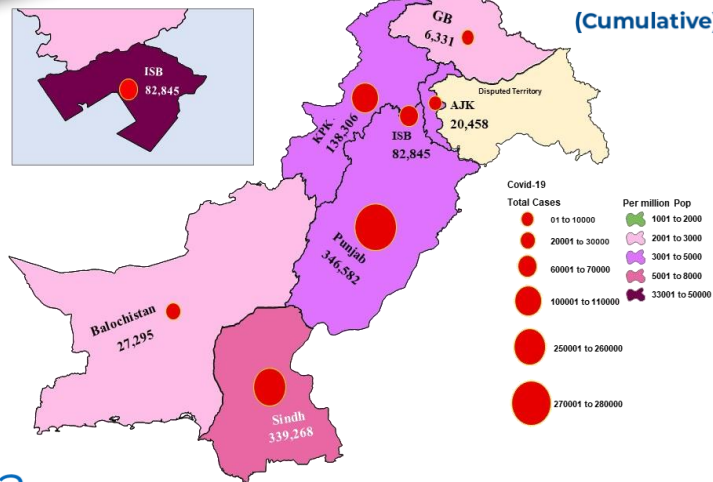

## PAKISTAN COVID-19 SNAPSHOT (Cumulative)

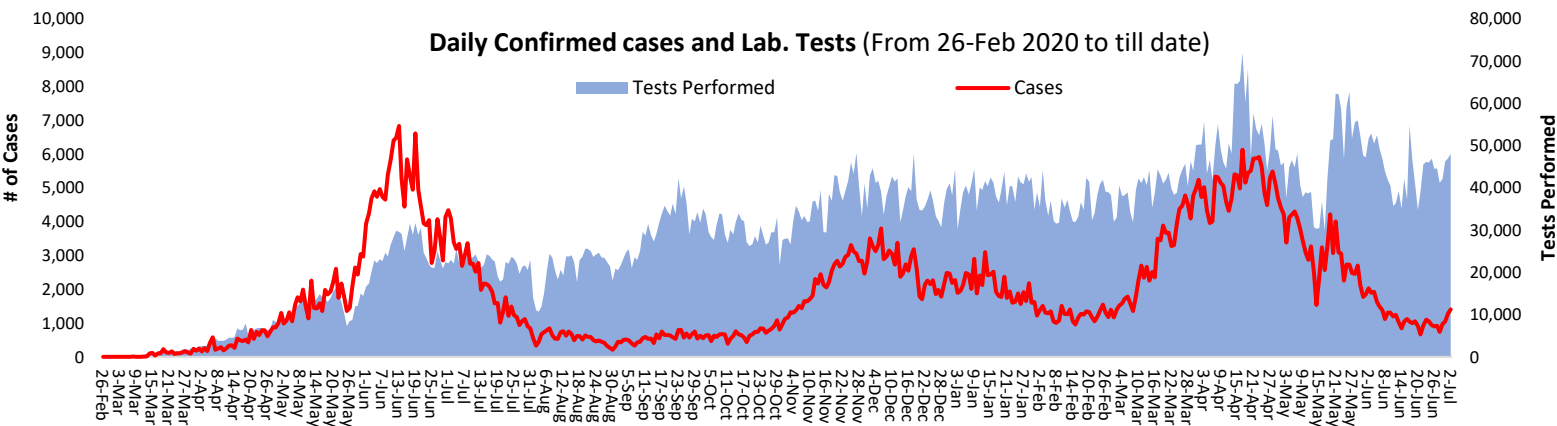
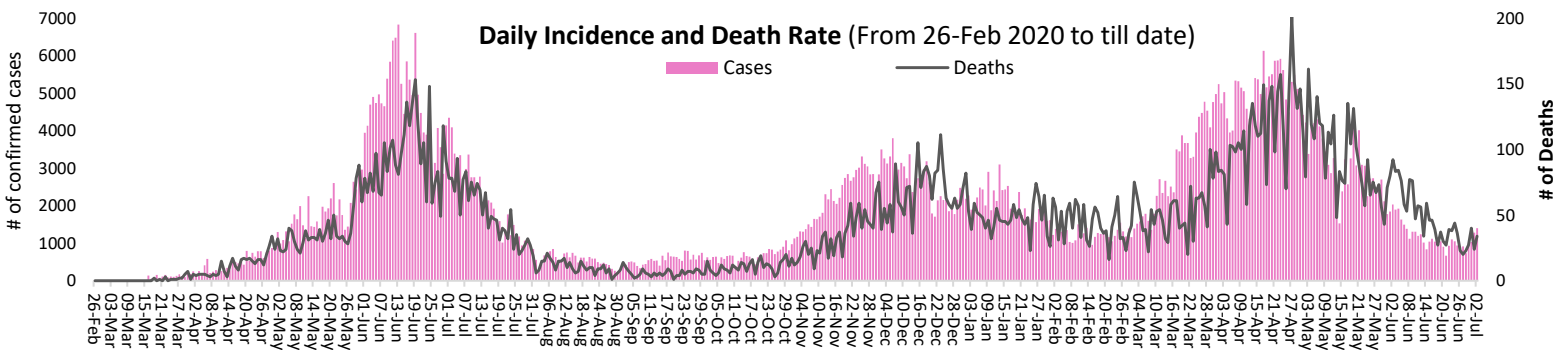

## Meeting and Coordination



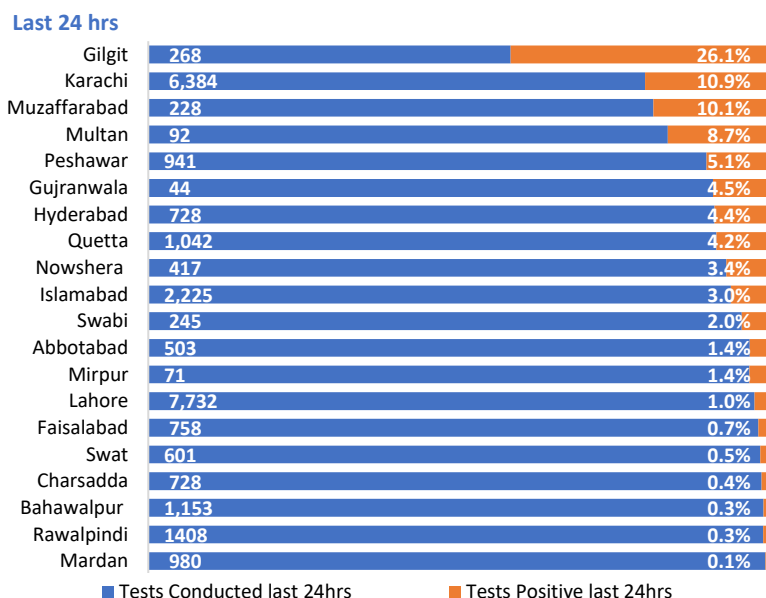
Dr Palitha Mahipala WHO Country Representative Pakistan visited the Community Midwifery School Brewery Road Quetta on 28<sup>th</sup> June 2021.

The WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala undertook a support supervision visit to Balochistan province from 27<sup>th</sup> to 29<sup>th</sup> June 2021. As part of his mission, he visited the Community Midwifery School on Brewery Road, Quetta on 28<sup>th</sup> June 2021. He was accompanied by Parliamentary Secretary for Health, Dr. Rubaba Buledi, Provincial Coordinator Maternal, Newborn & Child Health Dr. Ismail Merwani and Director Public Health Dr. Amin Khan.

During his visit, the WR donated: 550 Community Midwifery (CMW) curriculum books for use in 16 midwifery schools in the province; 2 Ultrasound Machines; Skill lab equipment for 3 CMW Schools (Quetta, Pishin and Panjgoor); assorted essential tools for 80 facilities and IT equipment to the Department of Health. This equipment are expected to improve the quality of training and services delivery, including timely referral of cases for advanced maternal, newborn and child health care.

Dr. Rubaba thanked the WR for the donation and pledged put the donated equipment to good use.
