

Executive Summary

Pakistan reported **330** new cases of COVID-19 on **02 August 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **280,029** with **5,984** deaths **(CFR: 2.13%)**. Out of the total **25,172** currently active cases, **1,595** cases are hospitalized, out of which **1,038 (65.07%)** are in critical condition. **23,577** COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or inhome isolation. A total of **248,873 (88.87%)** have recovered and discharged.

Daily incidence of COVID-19 cases in Pakistan






COVID-19 case density/million Population




Meeting & Coordination



Trends of COVID-19 cases, hospitalized, on ventilator & Deaths






