



### **INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE**




#### **TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.**




Pakistan reported 1,895 new cases of COVID-19 on 03 January 2021. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is 488,529 with 10,350 deaths (CFR: 2.12%). Out of the total 35,722 currently active cases 2,747 cases are hospitalized.
