





# **INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE**




### **TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.**




Pakistan reported **1,508** new cases of COVID-19 on **3**<sup>rd</sup> **February 2021**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **550,540** with **11,833** deaths **(CFR: 2.15%)**. Out of the total **32,889** currently active cases **2,430** cases are hospitalized.

The Office Incharge, WHO Pakistan, Dr Michael Lukwiya and Deputy Director MoNHSRC, Dr Sabeen Afzal inaugurated the training on 2<sup>nd</sup> February 2021. The training is being conducted from 2-4 February 2021 at Marriot Hotel Islamabad.

The purpose of the training is to train the senior management from 6 Public Sector Hospitals in Islamabad Capital Territory on implementation and institutionalization of WHO's Patient Safety Friendly Hospital Framework. Dr Sabeen Afzal appreciated WHO support for conducting this important training and suggested to coordinate with Islamabad Health Regulatory Authority for alignment of the PSFHF standards to take the Private sector also on board.
