

# **MEETING AND COORDINATION**

On 3rd March 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala attended a virtual meeting with WHO Headquarter and Department of Universal Health Coverage EMRO. The Objective of the meeting was to discuss the development of PHC oriented model of care in Pakistan. This initiative promotes high quality, people-centered primary health care and addresses essential public health functions as the core of integrated health services throughout the course of life by actions and interventions at policy, operations and community levels.

Dr. Palitha stated that WHO is working closely with the government for this, he mentioned the initiatives of introducing Family Practice based model of care, capacity building of health care providers in family medicine, digitalization of facility and community based activities (particularly LHWs), strengthening the DHO office and referral system. Lastly, Dr. Mahipala thanked the HQ and RO teams for their excellent and thoughtful contributions towards developing a model of care for ICT
