## **INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE**




#### **TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.**





Pakistan reported **3,262** new cases of COVID-19 on **03 December 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **410,072** with **8,260** deaths **(CFR: 2.01%)**. Out of the total **51,507** currently active cases **2,932** cases are hospitalized.

# **MEETINGS & COORDINATION**

Today, 4<sup>th</sup> December 2020, The WHO country representative Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala briefed health partners on the current situation of COVID-19 in the country and the processes of acquiring COVID-19 vaccine. The WR stated that WHO is working closely with global partners and the Government to ensure that COVID-19 vaccines arrive in the country as soon as its approved.

Ms Alexa Reynolds, Senior Country Manager GAVI for Pakistan briefed the participants on the COVAX facility and stated that Pakistan is one of the countries eligible for GAVI assistance. The WR in his concluding remark thanking partners for participating in the meeting and urged them to continue supporting the Government to maintain the gain in controlling COVID-19.
