



INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE




TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.




Pakistan reported **1,947** new cases of COVID-19 on **04 January 2021**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **490,476** with **10,409** deaths **(CFR: 2.12%)**. Out of the total **35,707** currently active cases **2,729** cases are hospitalized.

MEETINGS & COORDINATION

Today, 5th January 2021, WHO Pakistan donated assortment of biomedical equipment to the Services Hospital Lahore and handed over to the hospital administration. This donation was provided to address the important gaps identified during the Integrated Quality of Hospital Care Assessment for Improvement of Maternal and Neonatal Health service delivery in 20 hospitals across Pakistan.
