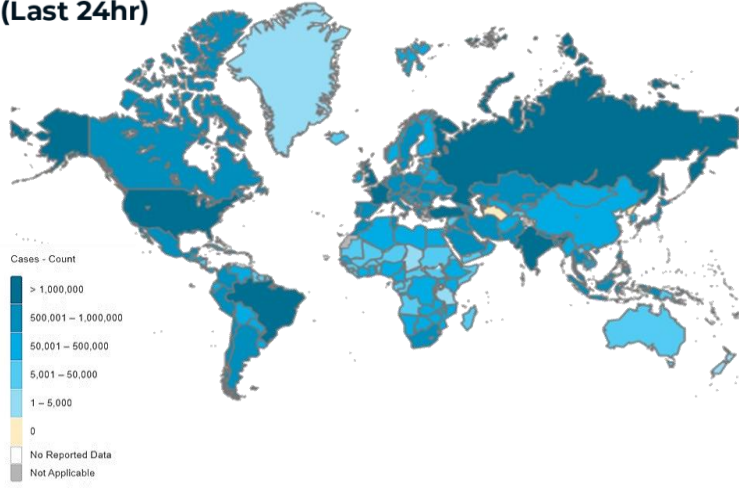




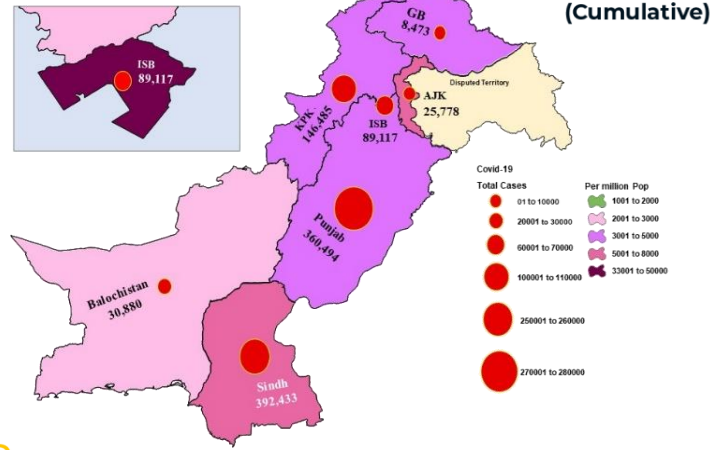

## PAKISTAN COVID-19 SNAPSHOT (Cumulative)

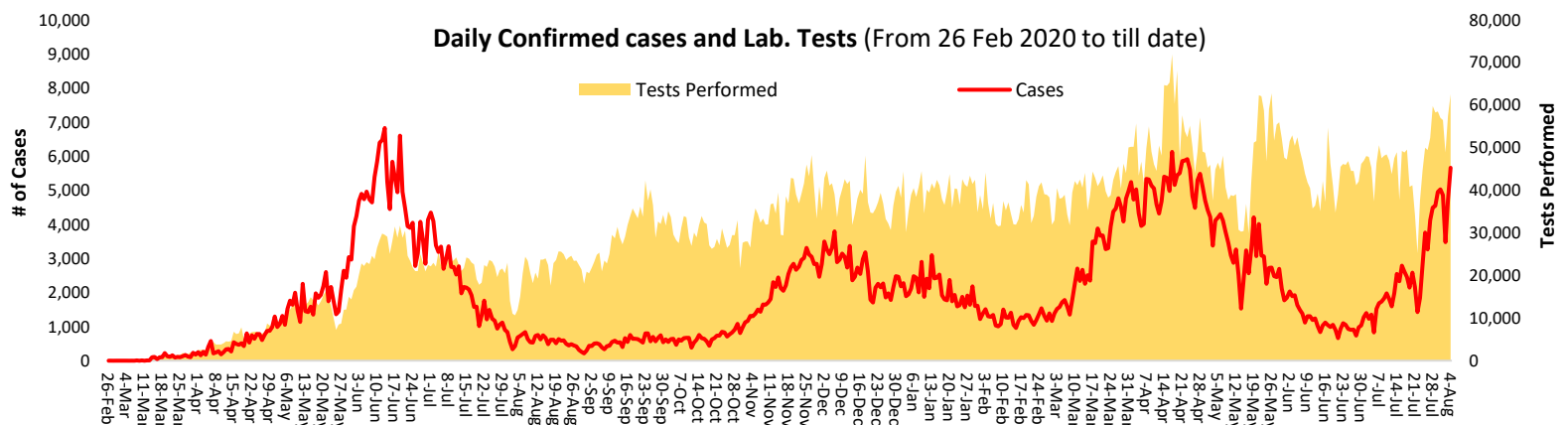
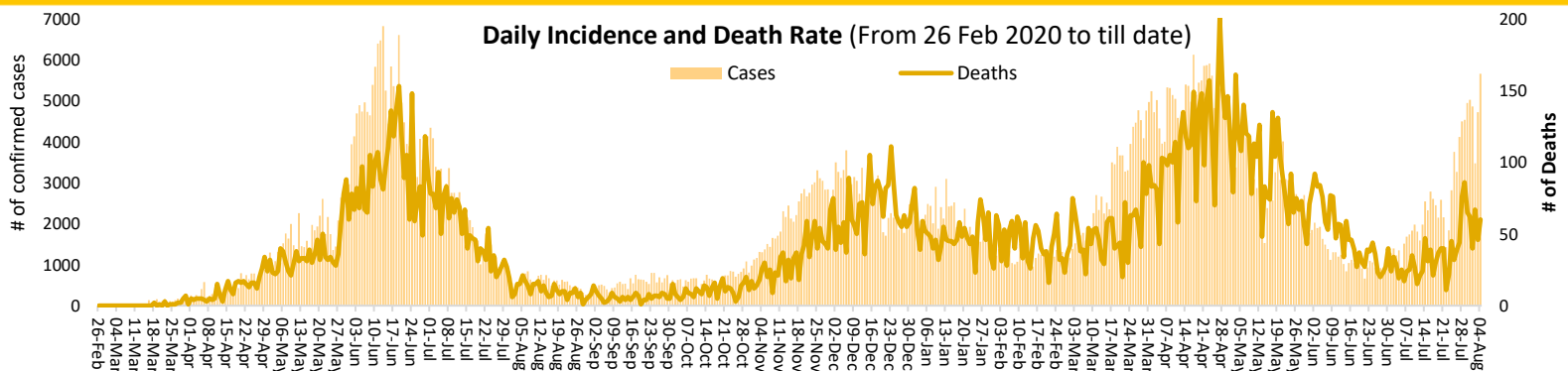

## Meetings & Coordination



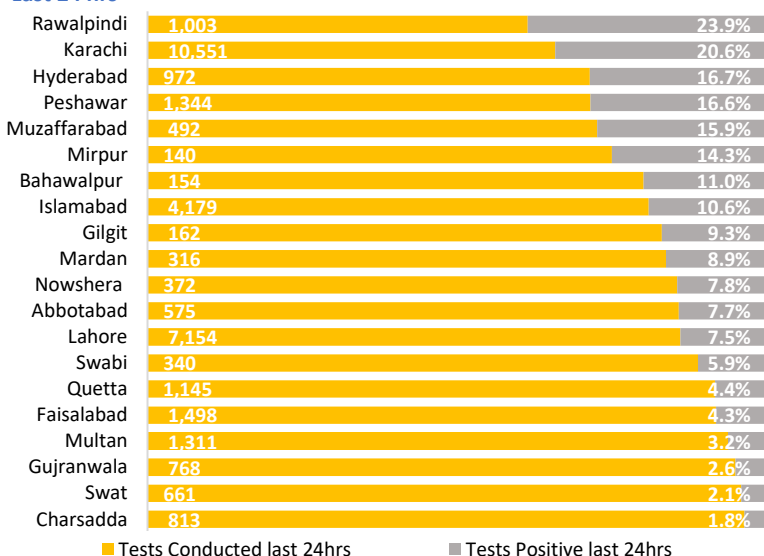
On 5<sup>th</sup> August 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala joined the Provincial Health Minister, Prof. Dr Yasmeen Rashid in the commemoration of the World Hepatitis Day 2021 at Governor House Punjab, Lahore.

Dr Palitha notified the audience that WHO supported the development of the first National Hepatitis Strategic Framework (2017-21), the development of the Provincial Hepatitis action plans for provinces of Punjab and Sindh, and the development of the National Guidelines for testing and management of Hepatitis B and C. The WR gave assurance of WHO's full commitment to the fight against viral hepatitis.

Prof. Dr Yasmeen Rashid appreciated WHO for the technical support towards the elimination of viral hepatitis by 2030.
