



#### **INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE**




#### **TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.**




Pakistan reported **3,119** new cases of COVID-19 on **04 December 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **413,191** with **8,303** deaths **(CFR: 2.01%)**. Out of the total **52,359** currently active cases **3,001** cases are hospitalized.
