



Executive Summary


Pakistan reported **513** new cases of COVID-19 on **4 September 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **298,025** with **6,340** deaths **(CFR: 2.12%)**. Out of the total **9,132** currently active cases, **1,017** cases are hospitalized, out of which **535 (52.60%)** are in critical condition. **8,115** COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or inhome isolation. A total of **282,553 (94.80%)** have recovered and discharged.

Daily Incidence/Mortality





Daily Incidence by Province





Daily COVID-19 Positivity Rate




COVID-19 Confirmed cases & CFR

FLOOD SITUATION

Saturday, 5th September 2020


In Pakistan, (3rd to 4th September 2020) heavy rains causing floods in many parts of the country resulting in human loss, infrastructure and property damage. According to NDMA overall, **69 houses** have been partially damaged, at least **18 houses** are fully damaged. The overall number of new deaths is **25**, with over **16** people injured.

In Khyber Pakhtunkhwa province (3rd to 4th September) the most affected province, heavy rains have resulted into severe floods and landslides. Over 13 new deaths, at least 06 new injured, 15 houses fully and 60 houses partially damaged. To date over **231 deaths**, over **155** Injuries have been recorded, 1,340 houses fully and 1,040 partially damaged since 15th June. See the table below for details.


