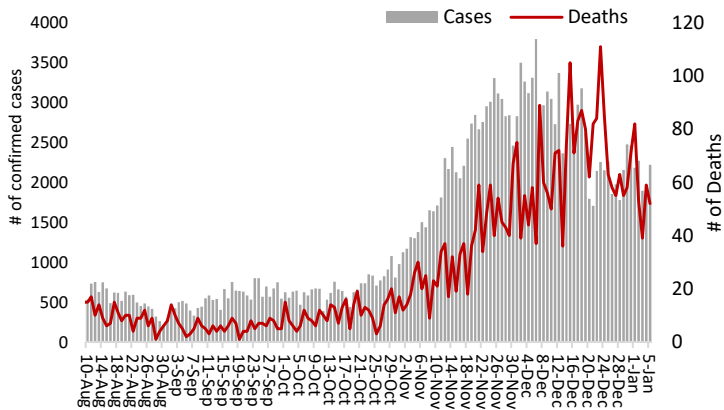

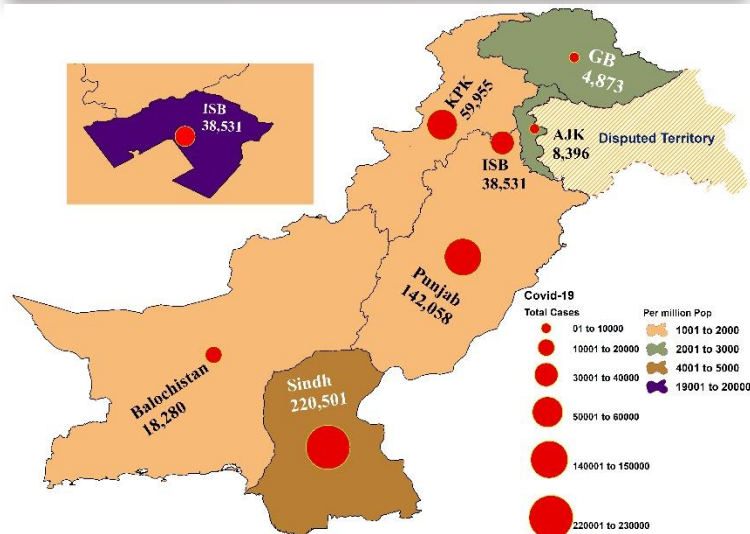


INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE

10-Aug 2020 - 05-Jan 2021



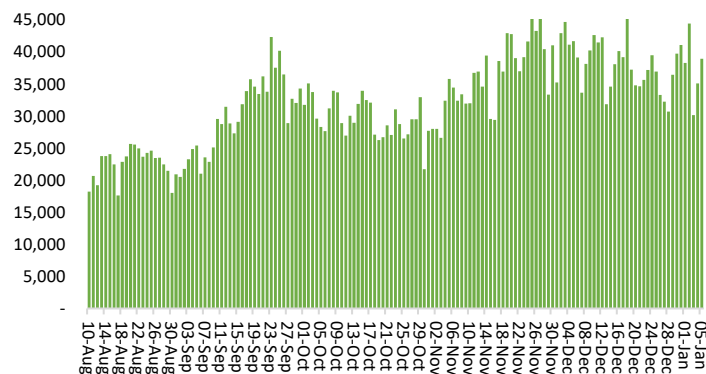
TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.



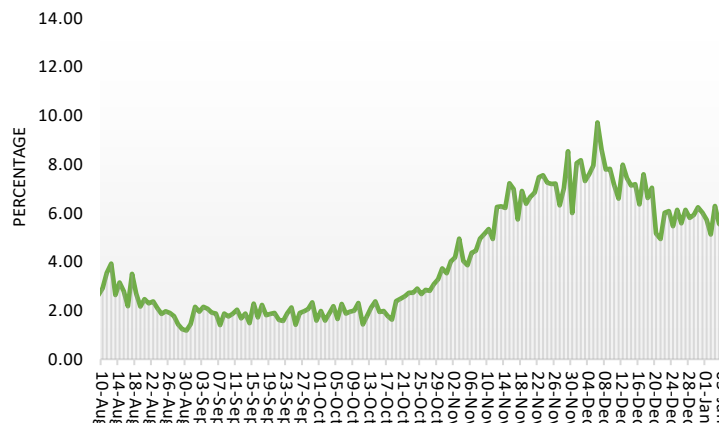
Pakistan reported **2,118** new cases of COVID-19 on **05 January 2021**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **492,594** with **10,461** deaths (**CFR: 2.12%**). Out of the total **33,740** currently active cases **2,759** cases are hospitalized.

MEETINGS & COORDINATION

Today, 6th January 2020, WHO Country Representative in Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala met the Counsellor and Attaché for cooperation and cultural affairs French Embassy Pakistan, Mr Mounir Slimani & Mr Dylan Gelard at the WHO Country Office Islamabad to discuss current COVID-19 situation in Pakistan.

Dr Palitha briefed the French embassy envoys on the current situation of COVID-19 cases, implementation of preventive measures to control infection spread and COVID-19 vaccines updates. WR emphasized that Pakistan must continue practicing the preventive measure and adherence to SOPs which are vital to control the pandemic.

Dr Palitha further briefed on the on-going COVID-19 operations, joint work by WHO and partners on the response activities, tracking the pandemic spread, technical advice on critical interventions, distribution of vital medical supplies to ongoing vaccine trials and vaccine roll out plans.
