





INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE




TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.




Pakistan reported 1,286 new cases of COVID-19 on 5th February 2021. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is 553,128 with 11,914 deaths (CFR: 2.15%). Out of the total 32,514 currently active cases 2,345 cases are hospitalized.

MEETINGS & COORDINATION

World Health Organization Pakistan provided support to the Government of Pakistan to launch the first phase of the COVID-19 vaccination. One of the supports include establishment of vaccination counters in designated health facilities and points of entry across the country. The vaccination counters were launched on Monday 1st February 2021 as detailed; In Sindh 190, Baluchistan 50, Punjab 200, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa 283, AJ&K 380 and Gilgit Baltistan 175 vaccine counters. The counters were provided with information, education and communication messages and other materials on COVID-19 vaccine.

The counters were launched in preparation for the simultaneous inauguration of COVID-19 vaccination drives in all the provinces and territories which took place on 3rd February 2021. The first phase of vaccination targets frontline Health Care Workers.
