



INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE




TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.




Pakistan reported **3,308** new cases of COVID-19 on **05 December 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **416,499** with **8,361** deaths **(CFR: 2.00%).** Out of the total **53,126** currently active cases **2,996** cases are hospitalized.

MEETINGS & COORDINATION

The World Health Organization Pakistan in collaboration with Provincial EPI Cell Punjab conducted one day comprehensive sentinel site surveillance review meeting on congenital rubella syndrome (CRS) on 1st December 2020 at Falettie's Grand hotel, Lahore.

The objective of the surveillance meeting was to assess hospital surveillance performance, identify gaps and formulate way forward.

Eight hospital staff from Children Hospital Lahore, Children Hospital Multan, Benazir Bhutto Hospital Rawalpindi and three divisional EPI officers attended this meeting. Participants were local surveillance coordinators, Microbiologist and data entry operators.
