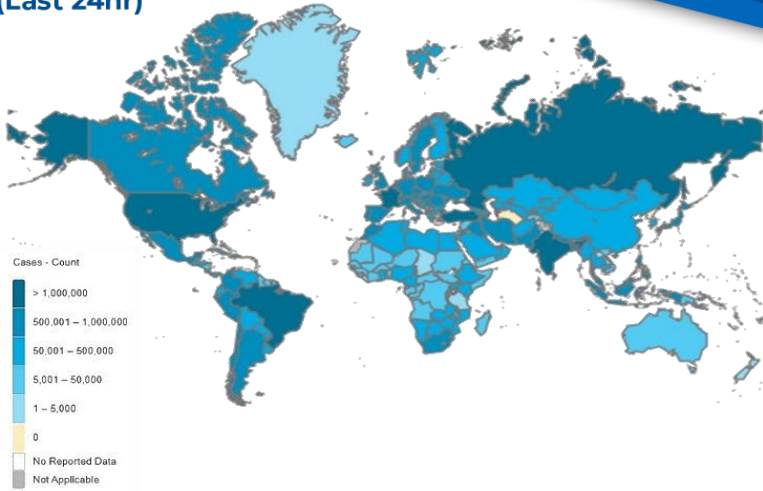


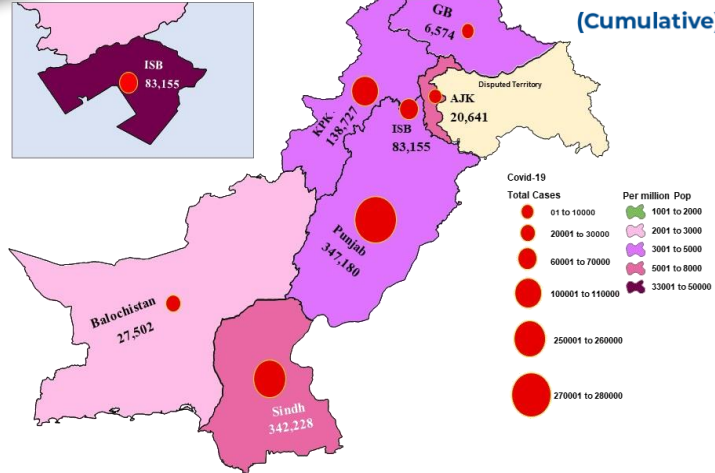

PAKISTAN COVID-19 SNAPSHOT (Cumulative)

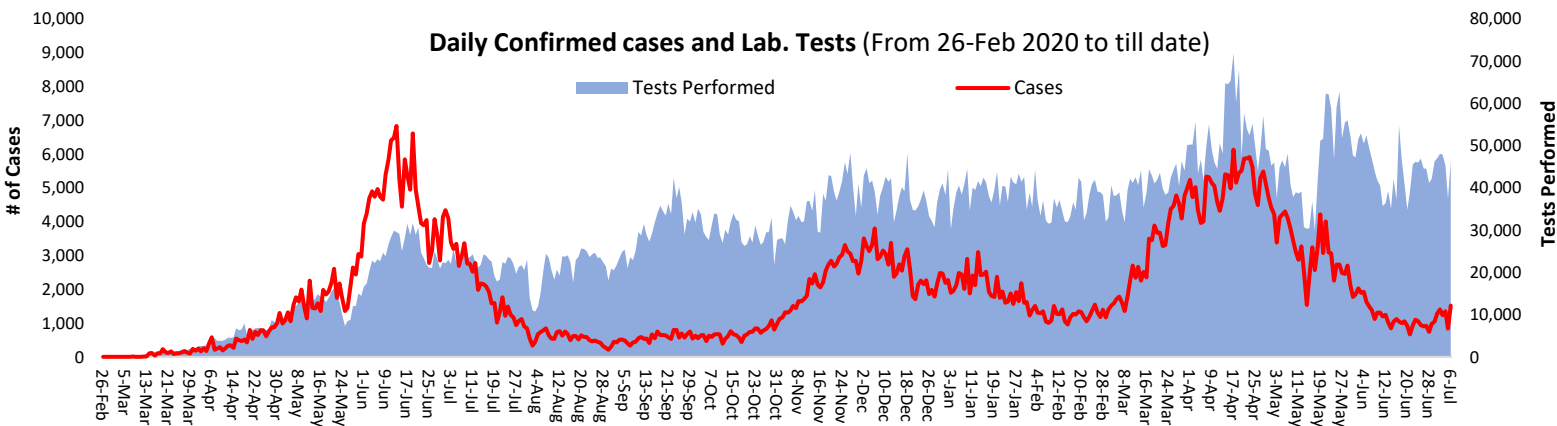
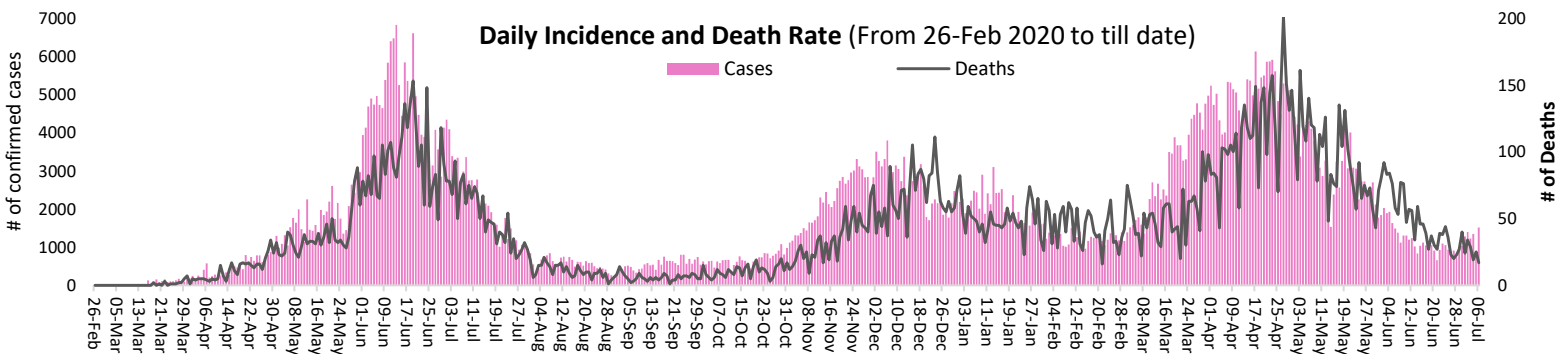

Meeting and Coordination

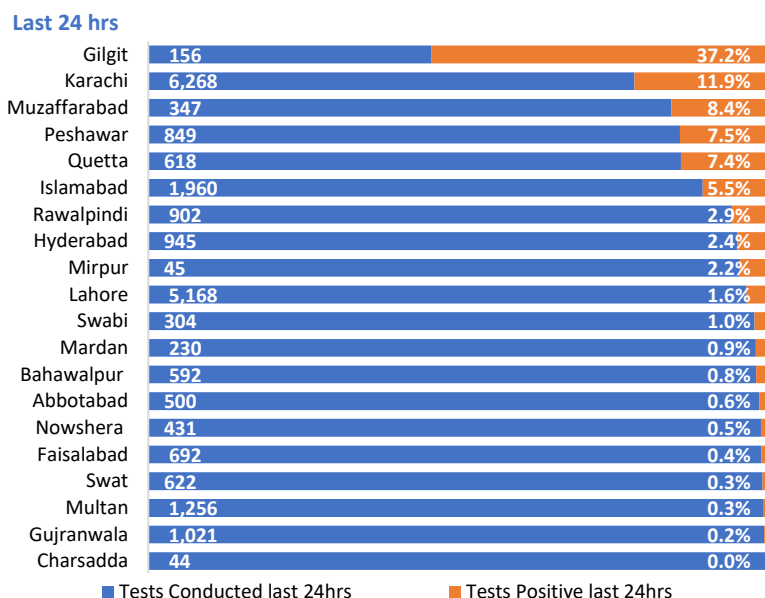


On 7th July 2021, the Ministry of National Health Services, Regulation & Coordination (MONHSR&C) in collaboration with the World Health Organization (WHO), Pakistan conducted the second meeting to develop Pakistan Preparedness and Response Plan (PPRP)-2021 in line with the evolving COVID-19 situation and priorities.

19 participants from MONHSRC, NIH, HSA, OCHA and WHO attended the meeting where technical officers from the 10 COVID 19 response pillars presented a situation analysis and recommendations for inclusion into the PPRP 2021.

The WHO Country Representative Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala in his address applauded the MoNHSR&C for effective response to COVID-19 and coordination in the development of PPRP 2021. The Deputy Director Programs, MONHSRC Dr Samra Mazhar appreciated WR for his technical guidance in the preparation of PPRP 2021.
