


PAKISTAN COVID-19 SITUATION REPORT

Saturday, 7th August 2021 (1 year & 163 Days)



Meetings & Coordination



On 4th August 2021, Health officials from district Loralai Balochistan province and WHO conducted a joint monitoring visit to the telemedicine center to assess the provision of sexual and reproductive healthcare services during the COVID situation. The team comprised of The District Health Officer, Dr Naqeebullah, Head of WHO Sub Office, Dr Asfand Yar Sherani and MNCH Technical Officer Dr Uzma Qudsia. The telemedicine center was established with support from WHO.

The team found that since inauguration in February 2021, 700 outpatient consultations including 250 pregnant women for antenatal care and 50 clients with sexual and reproductive healthcare needs were undertaken. During the visit, Dr Naqeebullah, thanked WHO for the support and noted that sustaining the operations of the telemedicine center has been possible due to involvement of the private sector.
